Ken Kolodner



Ken, has performed at performing arts centers and major festivals in nearly every state in the continental US as well as Canada and Europe. He has been featured in nationally broadcast concerts and programs on NPR, German National Radio, the CBC, the Voice of America, *the Thistle and the Sham-*

rock, and *All Things Considered* as well as countless television and radio broadcasts. His 1999 appearance with The Baltimore Choral Arts and chamber orchestra from the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra was broadcast in an **Emmy-nominated** CBS-TV Christmas special. Among Ken's eight recordings, Ken's first solo release of Celtic music in 1997, *Walking Stones*, was a top seller for BMG. Ken's 1999 recording *A Winter Solstice* with Helicon was the first release for Dorian Recordings to win a coveted "Indie" award. Ken's new CD, *Journey To The Heartland*, is due to be released later this year.

John Renwick

A North Carolina native, started playing the Mountain Dulcimer in 1994. Since then, his love of the instrument has led him to many festivals, fiddler's conventions, and contests. He has taught at festivals in 11 states and won blue ribbons at many of the events in the southeast. Including Union Grove, Mt. Airy, Galax and the NC State fair. John has taught several workshops and stresses his simple, but effective, style of playing. He says, "Playing the Dulcimer has become an extension of my soul. I often tell others, there are many players better than me, but few with more enthusiasm." He loves to sit down with beginners and "give some back" as he puts it.

Directions

From Rock Hill I-77

Take the highway-161exit, (right now it's 82-A but there is a lot of construction here) to York. Turn right at the bottom of the exit ramp, and merge into the traffic. Follow all signs to York – approximately 14 miles. As you enter the City of York, there will be a traffic light where you will see a Days Inn directly to your right. HWY 161 will become Liberty Street. Continue on Liberty Street about 1.5 miles past the Wal-Mart on your left and the BiLo on your right, until you come to Congress Street (3rd light from the Wal-Mart) Turn right onto Congress.

From I-85

Take Exit 8 onto Hwy 161. Go approximately 17 miles on Hwy 161, merge onto Hwy 321, which will be four lanes. Get into the left lane. Just past the Winn Dixie bear left on to 321 Business (Kings Mountain Street). Go to the end of Kings Mountain Street and turn right at the light onto Congress Street.

Old-Time Fiddle - 7:00 pm – 8:30 pm

This workshop will focus on various styles of bowing, and left hand ornamentation for playing old-time tunes. Several tunes will be taught. Bring a recording device!

Acoustic Jam! 8:30 pm – until?

Saturday, November, 20

Hammered Dulcimer I - 9:30am – 12:00 pm

This session is intended for the less experienced player and will focus on identifying basic chord structures, finding arpeggios, and a multitude of arranging ideas. Bring a recording device!

Hammered Dulcimer II - 1:30 pm – 3:30pm

This session will move at a quicker pace than Session I. However, players with less experience but attended session #1 are most welcome and will benefit from the class. This session will focus on arranging somewhat more complex pieces with a nearly endless supply of ideas! Bring a recording device!

Mountain Dulcimer - 1:30pm—3:30pm

This session will be adapted for both beginners and more advanced students alike. John will concentrate on the basics of the instrument and it's ease of playing. Topics will include holding the pick, strumming, tuning, and finish with learning a tune or two. Bring a recording device!
