The Georgia Board of Chiropractic Examiners reviewed your correspondence regarding Life University graduates.

The Board does not have authority to interpret federal or state law governing accreditation by the Council on Chiropractic Education nor court decisions or legal opinions. The board's authority is found in the Georgia practice act or law. Until such time as there is a federal or state law, court decision, official opinion, or CCE opinion that indicates that graduates of Life University are not eligible for licensure, the board is unable to respond further to your correspondence.
