

The *key facts* in *Fairbanks* are similar to the *Wilson Case*

"Fairbanks in a shocking display of corporate irresponsibility repeatedly fabricated the amount of the debtor's obligation to it out of thin air. There is no other explanation for the wildly divergent figures it concocted in correspondence with the Debtor and her agents and in pleadings and documents filed with the bankruptcy court."
