## What is MacVCD X?

MacVCD X is the easy to use video player for Mac OS X that plays VCD, SVCD, AVI, DivX, MPEG, video, Quicktime movies and more. This software offers all the playback features you need and the ease of use you really want from a video player. With Video CD Format recognition, you can play VCDs and SVCDs in just one step. You can also play all your other movies - XVCD, SXVCD, AVI, DivX, MPEG, video, Quicktime movies and more. Use the screen display you prefer - full screen display, small screen display (floating or regular window), or show on your TV. Get the features you want - movie saving, track selection and repeat track features, Photo VCD, multi-language and karaoke VCD support with this easy to use video player.

MacVCD X also features advanced features such as auto play, auto eject, Hands Free speech activated controls, fast-motion, slow-motion and backwards playback.

SVCD and VCD movies are frequently stored in multiple files (called tracks) and are often stored on more than one disk. MacVCD automatically recognizes this Video CD format, finds, loads and plays the movie for you, automatically chaining the tracks together for you and auto ejecting each disk when it's done.

(Note: SVCD/XSVCD, AVI, DivX playback require components. For more information, see "Systems Requirements" section of the Read Me.)

## Quick Start Instructions

These Quick Start Instructions will have you running MacVCD X in less than 15 minutes. If you need more detailed information about how to use MacVCD X or MacVCD X features, refer to the Read me.

## Quick Start Instructions

1. Drag the MacVCD X folder to the Application folder.
2. Double click the MacVCD X icon. A dialog appears when you launch the program, displaying four buttons:
 

<b>Quit</b>	to quit the program, click the "Quit" button
<b>Run Demo</b>	For further information, refer to the Read Me.
<b>Buy Now</b>	To buy this software now online, click the "Buy Now" button and follow the instructions.
<b>Register</b>	To register the software now, follow the instructions below.
3. Register MacVCD X.
  - Enter the License Type, Purchaser's Email ID and Registration Key supplied when you bought the product.
 

*If you purchased online, the easiest way to do this is to copy (Apple C) and paste (Apple V) the information from the email we sent you.*

*If you purchased using the "Buy Now" button, skip this step.*

*If you're running the free demo, skip this step.*
  - Click the "Register" Button
 

*If you have entered the Registration information correctly, the "Registered" message will be displayed.*

*If there is a problem with the registration information, the "Invalid Registration Information" dialog will appear. To correct the problem, refer to the "MacVCD X FAQ" in the documentation folder.*
4. To play a VCD, SVCD, XVCD or XSVCD, insert a Video CD into the CD drive. It will appear in the VCD menu.
 

*If Auto Play is enabled, the VCD will play automatically.*

*If Auto Play is not enabled, you need to manually start movie playback by clicking the play button..*

Note: SVCD/XSVCD playback requires that the Quicktime MPEG2 Playback Component be installed. For more information, see "Systems Requirements" section of the Read Me.
5. To play a QuickTime Movie, AVI, DivX, or Xvid, , SVCD, XVCD or XSVCD, open the file using the File>Open Menu item, navigate to the movie and click the Open button.

Click the Play button.

Note: AVI, Divx, Xvid playback requires that the Divx Component be installed. For more information, see "Systems Requirements" section of the Read Me.

Note: There is a known issue with AVI, DivX, Xvid playback on Intel Mac. For more information, see "Known Problems" section of the Read Me
