




Commentary

Legal Web sites are generally in line with the overall ISAR Index for Web development. These sites score well in terms of design, copywriting, and ease of use. They score lowest in innovation and use of technology. Legal Web sites have slightly under performed each of the 3-year criteria benchmarks.


The top legal Web sites are more than just brochureware. They provide meaningful industry news and analysis within their various practice areas.
