




Commentary

Family orientated Web sites have consistently outperformed the ISAR Index for the past nine years. They are one of a hand ful of sites that excel year after year. On the other hand, 3-year average criteria scores are generally in line with the overall averages and slightly exceed the averages in content, interactivity, copywriting, and ease of use.


Family Web sites tend to do very well at understanding the needs of their audience and using the latest technolgy to meet those needs.
