
Introduction

ZsCompare, the award winning file comparison utility from Zizasoft, allows you to synchronize computers, backup data, compare different versions of files, verify that CDs have been copied correctly, manage Zip files, review changes to source code, and more. Users can easily run comparisons on local directories or across networked computers. Comparisons can also be performed on removable media such as CDs, DVDs, and flash drives. ZsCompare is highly customizable to meet a wide range of needs.

ZsCompare allows you to manually or automatically compare and synchronize files, folders, and zip files between local directories or networked computers.

ZsCompare enables you to perform line by line comparisons of text files, Microsoft Word documents, and PDF documents, and then merge the files to include only the changes you want. Predefined options for common comparisons provide additional control over how the comparison is performed. ZsCompare permits direct editing of the contents of a file from the results.

Also, you can compare freeform text that has been input either by typing it in, or by copying the text from other applications.

Cross-Platform Availability and Three Editions

ZsCompare 3.0 operates on Windows, Mac OS X (including PowerPC-based Macs and Intelbased Macs), and Linux, and is available in three editions: Professional (\$199.95), Standard (\$99.95), and Lite (\$35.00).

The **Lite Edition** contains basic comparison and synchronization functionality. With the Lite Edition, users can compare directories, zip files, text files, and freeform text.

The **Standard Edition** contains all of the features in the Lite Edition plus it adds several additional features to increase productivity. The Standard Edition includes support for creating and comparing snapshots as well as support for changing attributes, timestamps, and file names directly from directory comparison results. The Standard Edition includes powerful text comparison options, and the ability to directly edit the text of a file from the results. Users can view the results in a binary mode to compare non-textual files. Also, you can create patches that can be used to store revisions of files in a compact manner or to send changes to remote users in a compact manner.

The **Professional Edition** contains all of the features in the Standard and Lite Editions plus support for comparing the text of Microsoft Word documents and PDF files. The Professional Edition also lets users create and run scripts to automate zsCompare.

All versions include free lifetime upgrades and free technical support.

The next section further describes some of the features available in each edition of zsCompare.

Common Business and Home Uses

ZsCompare can be used in many ways to simplify common business tasks, as well as tasks required by home users. The following are just a few ways that zsCompare can simplify day-to-day activities.

Compare Directories

ZsCompare allows you to easily compare directories to find differences. You can then synchronize the results in order to update the files within the directories. ZsCompare allows you to change what is compared during a directory comparison and how it is compared to ensure the best results.

Backup Files

A successful backup strategy consists of storing data to another location, making sure the data you backed-up was copied correctly, and recovering data from the backup location when necessary. With zsCompare, you can automatically or manually back your computer up to either a local directory, pre-formatted removable media (such as a writable CD), or a networked computer. You can then synchronize files and folders to the backup location, or restore files and folders from the backup location. You can also test that the backup was done correctly by comparing the backup to the source files. This guarantees that you can successfully restore files from backup if the need arises.

Synchronize Laptop and Desktop Computers

Keep desktop and notebook computers in sync. If you use more than one computer, you know the frustration of not having a file on the computer that you know exists on your second computer. With zsCompare, you can ensure that your laptop and desktop computers are synchronized, without the hassle of manually copying files back and forth.

Compare Important Documents

Comparing different versions of documents (such as contracts, RFP's, customer letters, etc...) is often necessary to ensure accuracy. This is especially true if the document has been worked on by different people in your office or that have been sent to clients for review. ZsCompare features built-in support for comparing files that are saved as text files as well as the ability to compare non-text files like Word documents, Excel spreadsheets, and PDF documents. When comparing files that are not text based, zsCompare does not require you to export the original file to a text file. This eliminates the need to save files only for comparison purposes. You can even compare files that are not saved in the same format. For example, you can compare a Word document to a PDF file that was created from the Word document to ensure they still match.

Manage Zip Files

Zip files compress files so they take up less space on your hard drive. Zip files are very useful for sending files to other users, and backing up files. When working with the files in a Zip file, they are extracted from the file, modified, and then re-added to the Zip file. With zsCompare, you can create new Zip files, delete Zip files, update Zip files, and extract files from Zip files.

Verify CDs

After you have created a CD, you should verify that the copy is exactly identical to the original files. ZsCompare makes this easy by letting you run a comparison of the CD with the source files. You can either verify the CD by comparing the CD which was just created to the original files, or if you are using the Standard or Professional editions of zsCompare you can create a snapshot of the CD contents to compare with the original files. Using a snapshot is much faster because the checksums are pre-calculated.

Common Software Development Uses

Software developers can use zsCompare to greatly reduce the time it takes to perform common tasks. Also, zsCompare can help developers verify various aspects of their daily routines. The following are some of the ways that zsCompare can help developers.

Compare File Revisions

Developers can use zsCompare to compare file revisions during code check-in, code reviews, and when researching past changes. After the comparison has finished, the results of the comparison will be displayed and you can make any modifications you need.

Compare Test Results

Development teams commonly need to verify the output of programs to ensure that the application being tested is working properly. ZsCompare allows you to compare output either automatically or manually. If anything is wrong, you can use zsCompare to easily compare the expected and actual results.

Compare Registry Files

If you are using the Standard or Professional editions of zsCompare, you can easily compare registry files that have been exported from the Windows Registry. This can be useful to create snapshots of your registry when you are in a known working state and then compare to a current version of the registry if a program begins to work improperly. Software developers can also use it to confirm that programs you are developing are working with the registry properly.

Create and Apply Patches

Patches can be used to store revisions of files in a compact manner or to send changes to remote users. Patches are available in both the Standard and Professional editions of zsCompare. However, in the Standard Edition of zsCompare, you can only create patches between two files. In the Professional Version, you can create patches of multiple files and patches of directories.

Verify Installations

If you are part of a development team working on creating an installation, you will need to verify the installation is copying the correct files to a target computer, and that the files are being written with the correct attributes. ZsCompare makes this easy, by allowing you to compare a test computer with a computer that has the correct files on it, or by creating a snapshot with the correct files and comparing the snapshot to the test installation.

System Requirements

Individual License Prices

Individual licenses allow the use of zsCompare on a single machine. If you wish to use zsCompare on multiple machines, you must purchase a license for each machine.
