I have to say it but I am in total shock! You see it seems that every week there is a hot new software that will do this or that and guarantee you number one position on the world famous "big three".

I have to be honest, am I the only one getting sick of (please excuse my French) all the hype and bullshit that is fed to the internet marketing crowd? Sometimes I feel that if some "guru" was to tell us that wearing our underpants on our head would get us number one position we would suddenly more Calvin Klein than I care to think about.

Lets face it, there is a whole lot of "hope" being sold, but not a lot of real, "take it to the bank" action!

Anyway I digress, let me get back to the point...

2 days ago I was reading a forum where a bloke (I wont mention his name) was telling the world of how he went from a PR 0 brand new domain to PR 6 (yes, that is SIX) all in less than 1.5 months. Not only for the main domain, but also to any domain he linked to!

If you are anything like me, your bullshit meter should be sitting in the red zone right now, so I decided to do a little investigating myself.

Lucky for me this guy had let slip his main keyword phrase and I'll let you know it's a competitive one with over 43,000,000 competing pages on Google! Guess what? He's

number one on MSN with the other two SE giants nipping at his toes! How pissed of would they be ☺ !

Well what could I do but think “I need to find out if this is the truth or a total crock...”

I bought the software, ok at \$297 it's not cheap but it had a guarantee so what was there to loose. Ok I did the plunge.

Doing my research, it seems that the software can be very intense on the server, at least during the setup. Keeping in mind that HostGator (hey I love you guys) may not be too happy if I ground their servers to a halt, I decided to go with a service that is 100% behind this software.

The guys at <http://GreatSEOWebhosting.com> love the software so much that they went out and bought 2 new servers just for hosting this super blog machine!

Less then an hour after signup I was sent the details of my login, and they even installed the software for me! Seriously what host does that? Anyway I digress, yet again.

Once logging into the software I spent 20 minutes doing some simple tweaks to the templates (noting hard core, just enough to make them mine) and then loaded up 1000 keywords that I want to work with.

After checking my settings (all done with the training videos, I'm not that good with computers you see) and setting up three simple cron jobs (that you can cut and past directly from the software) and my new baby blog farm was ready to go...

So off to sleep I go wondering if this software really is as hot as they say...

By the next morning I was the proud owner of 290 blogs, each with 6 or so posts in them with the other 1000 to be made slowly over the next month. Stoked with that, I went to work and decided to check my stats when I got home.

Boy was I in for a surprise....

My blog had been crawled like they were looking for oxygen on Mars! Over 5,000 hits – all by spiders. But this is the kicker, **908 of those hits were from Googlebot**, the hardest bot to get to visit, and this was in less the 20 hours after buying the domain!

Don't believe me? Have a look at the photo on the next page, it's a screen cap of hits from my cpanel of the new domain.

And this is the kicker, with the software you can add links to just one or all of the blogs, to one, two or all the thousands of the posts.
How would you like to instantly create your own farm of highly responsive backlinks?
And we all know what backlinks mean, → "Top Rank Positions".

Well guys I hope that you have found this report of my domains first 24 hours a bit of an eye-opener. I have to say that even I, the internet cynic, and gob smacked.

If you are interested in creating your own spider frenzy I strongly suggest you have a look not only at <http://UltimageBlogMachine.com> but also at <http://SuperSEOWebhosting.com> as these two seem to work perfectly together like hand and glove.

In these competitive days of SEO positioning can you really afford not to be using this software?
