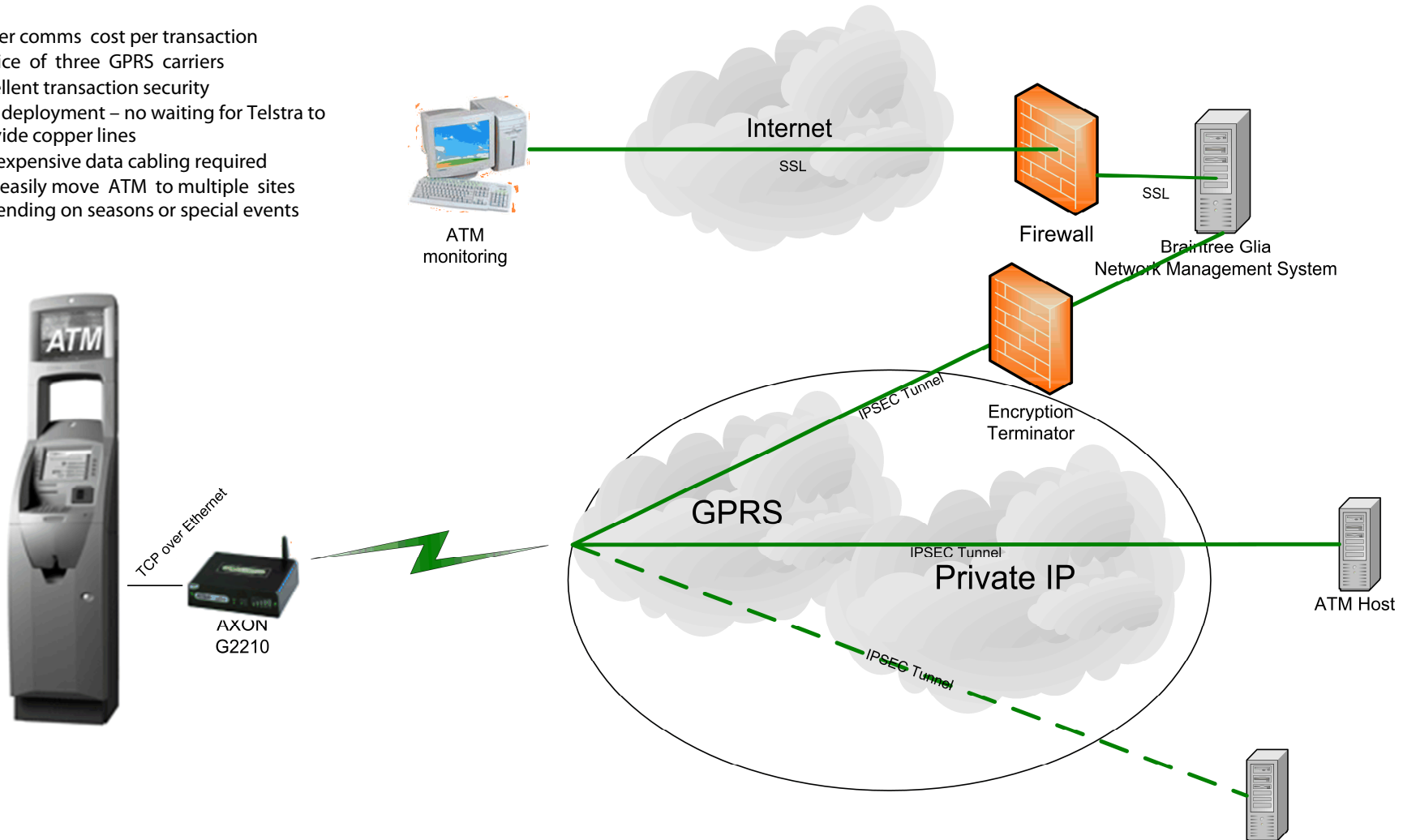


# Typical Bank ATM Deployment with Glia Network Management
