



OCTOBER HIGHLIGHTS UNCLE SHUCK'S CORN MAZE AND PUMPKIN PATCH

WHAT: Uncle Shuck's Corn Maze and Pumpkin Patch in Dawson County is a 20-acre "agri-tainment" complex that operates each fall when the 12-foot cornstalks become living pathways. 2006 marks the 5th season and the new trails are cut to form the outline of a stock car and checkered flags.

October Special Events include Scout Weekends and Haunted Trail. Ghosts, goblins, and quicksand will provide a spooky rather than gory experience among the cornfield for nine haunted nights. The popular Haunted Trail is a separate one-mile section of the maze designed by the two Sheriff's Office Explorer programs to entertain teenagers and adults and serve as their main fall fundraising project.

WHEN: The maze, seasonal pumpkin patch and other onsite activities are open for 12 consecutive weekends, from September 2 to Nov 19. Uncle Shuck's Corn Maze and Pumpkin Patch is open every day in October. Times and dates are listed below, and at www.uncleshucks.com.

WHERE: 4525 Highway 53 East, Dawsonville, GA 30534. Uncle Shuck's Corn Maze and Pumpkin Patch is only 30 minutes from metro Atlanta, just two miles east of the North Georgia Premium Outlet Mall on GA 400.

PRICE: Just \$9 for adults, \$8 for children (ages 3-12), \$8 for seniors (ages 60 and over), free for children under 3. Take a tractor-drawn hay ride and enjoy roasted marshmallows at the bonfire for an additional \$4 per person. Save with a combo ticket - maze, hay ride and bonfire pass for just \$11 per person. The Haunted Maze (see dates below) is \$2 additional per person, with proceeds benefiting the Dawson County and Forsyth County Sheriff's Office Explorer Program. Group rates available upon request.

FREE: Enjoy a Picnic Pavillion, children's soybean maze, Sunflower Garden, tractor display at the venue.
