Mobile UC will be available for The Research in Motion blackberry devices and Microsoft windows mobile devices for version 8.0 generally available in early 2007. Release 7.0 also provides integration with Mitel, 3Com, Avaya, NEC, Iwatsu Networks, Toshiba, Panasonic, Ericsson, Cisco, Nortel, and SIP based phone systems. Organizations can implement a software application over their existing telephony network simply by deploying the Telephony Office-LinX.

Telephony Office-LinX is already tightly integrated with Microsoft Windows, Exchange, Office, Terminal Services and Outlook. It can be administered directly from an organization's Microsoft Management Console or through Terminal Services over the web. Users can be managed through Active Directory and Group Policy.
