Prior to this release, many companies had to struggle with the setup and maintenance of an in-house Exchange server, putting a limit on those who wanted the features but did not want to manage it.

With the second version of hosted Exchange coming out, Exchange 2007, there are still a relatively small number of companies offering a hosted solution. An in-house solution can cost thousands of dollars to set up and maintain, while a hosted solution can often be set up for less then \$10 per user per month. This is ideal for small to medium size companies that needs its power.

Within this small niche, it is important to know which companies offer which service. Some companies offer 99% or 100% uptime guarantees, while others do not. Some offer 24x7 local support while other outsource their support to other countries.
