What is Aglow's mission?

How does Aglow “help restore and mobilize women?”

Through mentoring and encouragement, Aglow helps women foster a deep relationship with God which in turn promotes healing and restoration. Aglow wants women to rediscover their God-given power, beauty and purposes, and this is done through relationship with their creator. To mobilize is “to gather together, to activate, to assemble.” Since 1967, Aglow has been investing in and developing women to become servant leaders in their communities. A quick phone call to an Aglow woman in any city, state or country and Aglow is mobilized to meet a need or respond to a crisis.

Are there men involved with Aglow?

Yes. Men in countries around the world are joining Aglow because they believe in our mission.

Aglow has a 40-year history. What are they doing in the future?

For years, Aglow women overseas have been actively involved in works of compassion, empowerment, and training as part of their evangelistic efforts, specifically in refugee camps and war-torn nations. A subsidiary of Aglow International has been incorporated for humanitarian and compassion purposes called Aglow Relief, which is in the process of applying for 501(c)(3) status with the federal government to give Aglow's international leaders entrée to funding sources in their respective nations.
