GROOVY GODDESS: Celebrate the female spirit, empower a woman, change the world.™

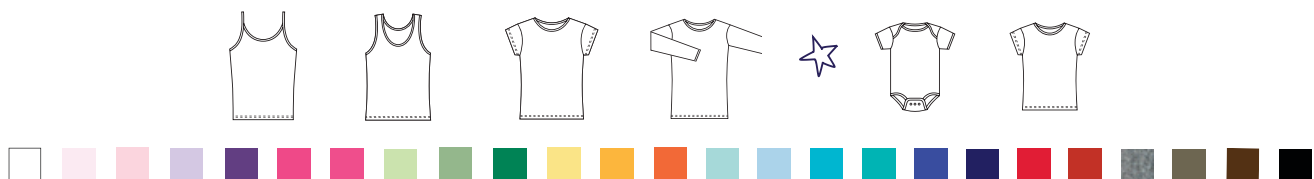

She embodies the delicate balancing act all modern women must perform.



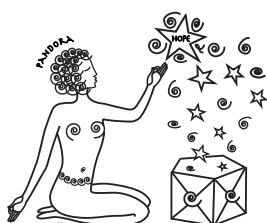

WILLENDORF

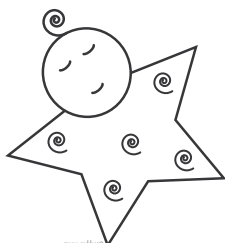

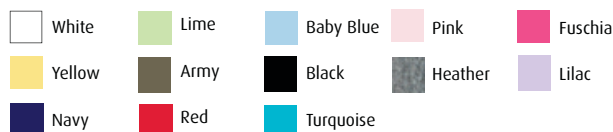
Ladies' Spaghetti Strap Tank Top

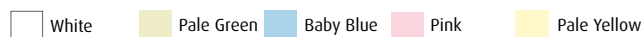

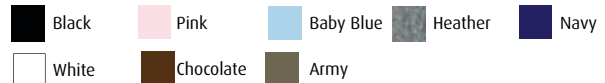

Cotton Spandex Yoga & Workout Pants

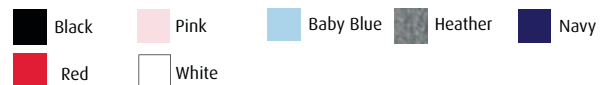

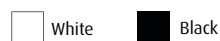

Cotton Spandex Roll Down Skirt

Since then she has held executive and managerial positions in Silicon Valley’s start-ups and Fortune 100 companies. From concept to design to execution to market, over 100 products are attributable to her leadership, design, technology, and operation skills.

Corinne simultaneously cultivated her artistic flair in creative venues. She produced industrial films and shorts. Her contemporary photography is featured by Hakone Gardens, a US National Landmark.
