

The drawing below illustrates how the TransNexus solution complements an SBC. When an SBC receives an inbound call leg, the SBC sends a route query to the TransNexus platform for optimum routing instructions based on cost, quality, access control and other business policies. The SBC then completes the call to the destination returned by the TransNexus platform. When the call is completed, the SBC sends a Call Detail Record (CDR) to the TransNexus platform for traffic analysis, rating and billing.
