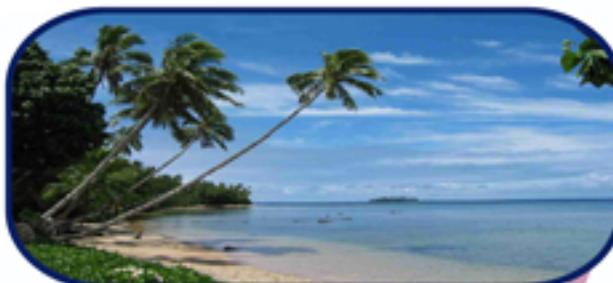

One important variable is the ability to effectively communicate in English if you work for a United States airline. Flight attendants must deal with emergency situations in which effective communication is imperative. There are times when instructions must be given to customers and it is very important for you to clearly understand the customers as well. The following information was taken from the websites of several different airlines, and you can see how this is an important requirement. Flight attendants:

- Must be aware of hazardous situations and be able to provide a Leadership role in emergencies as needed.
- Must have excellent verbal communications and interpersonal skills.
- Must have the ability to read, write, speak, and understand the English language.
- Are required to successfully complete pre-employment physical examination that reveals no physical or mental limitations that would impair ability to perform routine or emergency job duties.
