# **OFFICIAL RULES**

# ENTRY CATEGORIES AND ELIGIBILITY

The three categories in the Gingerbread House Contest include:

Children, 12 and Under – any child aged 12 or under may enter the contest

Home Cooks - for those aged 13 and over who are not professional chefs or in culinary school

**Professional Chefs and Culinary School Students** – for those working professionally in the culinary arts or currently enrolled in culinary school

All entries are invited to donate their gingerbread house, whether it wins an award or not, to Coastside Children's Programs for the silent auction at The Ritz-Carlton, Half Moon Bay on Sunday, December 9, 2007.

# ENTRY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All gingerbread houses must measure a maximum of 3'x3'x3' and be supported by a strong, flat base that is fully transportable. To qualify, *all materials* used in the gingerbread houses must be edible, with the exception of the support structure or frame, lighting, and the base. A completed entry form is required for each creation. The deadline for entry forms is Thursday, November 29, 2007, without exception. Entering the contest is complimentary. Individuals or groups may submit entries, although each entry must have <u>one</u> official entrant name, title and authorized signature on an entry form. The contest is limited to one entry per person or group.

Entries will be accepted at the main entrance of The Ritz-Carlton, Half Moon Bay at OneMiramontes Point Road in Half Moon Bay, between the hours of 8 a.m. to 8 p.m, Friday, November 30 through Monday, December 3. Houses entered after 8 p.m. on Monday, Dec. 3 will not be eligible for judging, but may still be displayed and entered into the silent auction. Entrants are responsible for transporting their gingerbread house to the hotel. All entries will be on display at The Ritz-Carlton, Half Moon Bay from Tuesday, December 4 through Sunday, December 9, 2007. All entries not donated to Coastside Children's Programs must be picked up from the hotel by 5 p.m. Monday, December 10, or they will be discarded or donated to charity.

# **JUDGING**

Judging of all gingerbread house entries in all categories and prize levels will take place from 1 to 3 p.m. Sunday, December 9, 2007. Each entry will be assigned a number to ensure unbiased judging.

Pastry chefs from The Ritz-Carlton, Half Moon Bay will lead a group of judges in selecting the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in each category. Criteria include structural design, creative use of materials, detailing, and overall excellence. Members of the public are invited to cast their ballots for the People's Choice Award in each category. Announcement of all winners will take place at 5 p.m. on Sunday, December 9, 2007 at The Ritz-Carlton, Half Moon Bay's annual Holiday Tree Lighting Ceremony. All decisions are final.

# **CONTEST PRIZES**

Each qualifying gingerbread house entered into the contest is eligible for the following prizes, which will be awarded to the winner in person or by mail if entrant is not at awards ceremony:

Children, 12 and under: 1st - \$200; 2nd - \$150, 3rd - \$100; People's Choice - \$50.

**Home Cooks:** 1<sup>st</sup> - One Overnight Stay in Coastal View Room and Chef's Tasting Dinner for Two in Navio; 2<sup>nd</sup> - Chef's Tasting Dinner for Two in Navio; 3<sup>rd</sup> - Admission for two to any two "Inside the Kitchen" cooking class from January through April 2008; People's Choice - Two 60-minute treatments of choice in The Ritz-Carlton Spa.

**Professional Chefs and Culinary School Students:** 1<sup>st</sup> -Admission for two to the 2007 New Year's Eve Gala; 2<sup>nd</sup> - One Overnight Stay in a Coastal View Room; 3<sup>rd</sup> - Chef's Tasting Dinner for Two in Navio; People's Choice - Two 60-minute treatments of choice in The Ritz-Carlton Spa.
