Follow the steps below to learn how it works.

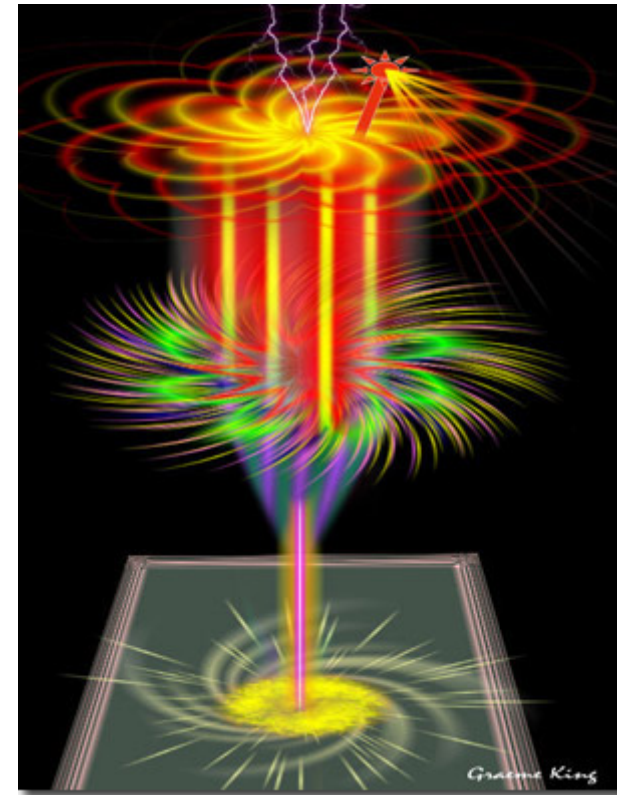

1. Open your photo editor and create a new document.

Add a new layer. We should color the background image into black to make our image visible.

2. Let's make the glass base.

Firstly create a new layer and call **AKVIS LightShop**. Choose **Sample 26** and

press the button  (Fig. 2).

Press the button  to apply the result and close the plugin window.

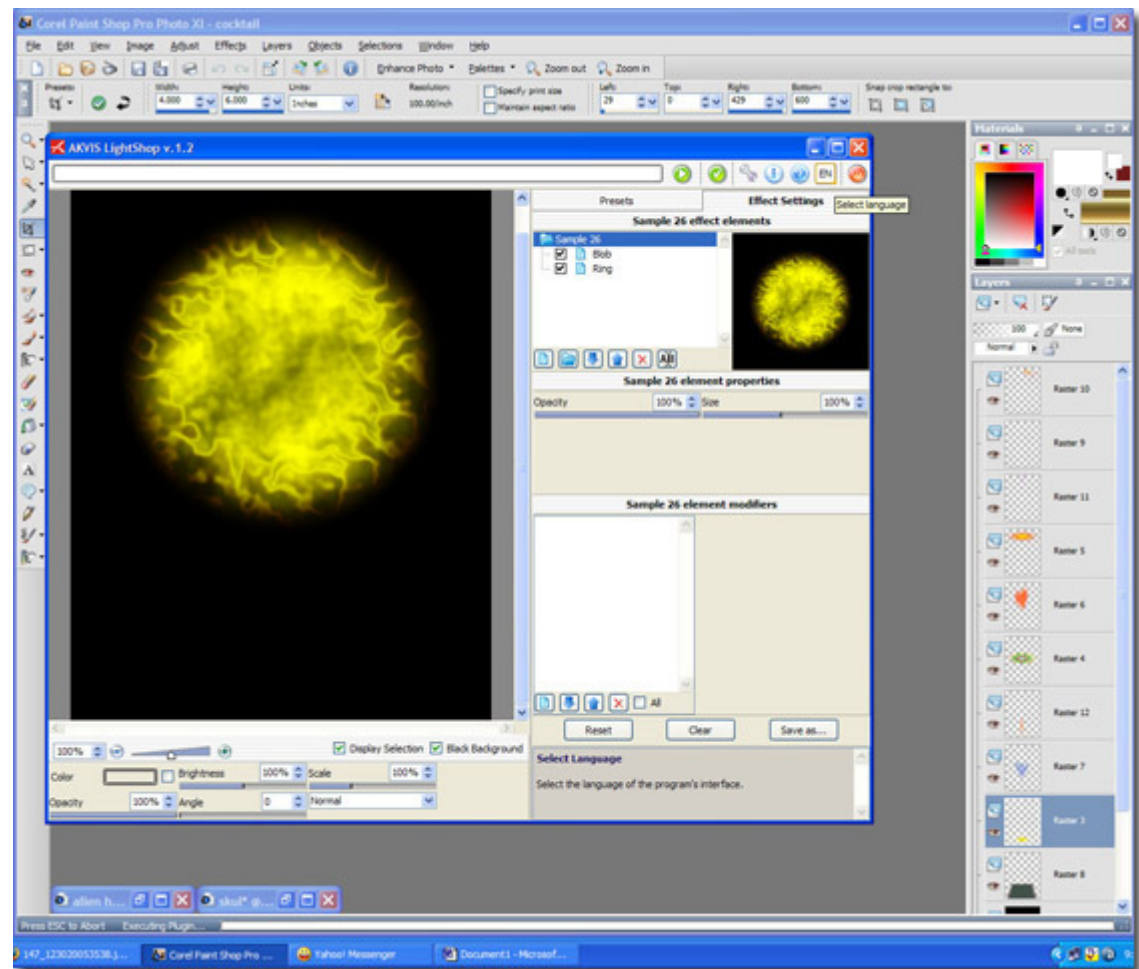

3. Call **AKVIS LightShop** again and choose another preset (**Sample 12**) (Fig. 3).

Change the settings as you like and press the button .

Apply the result by pressing the button .

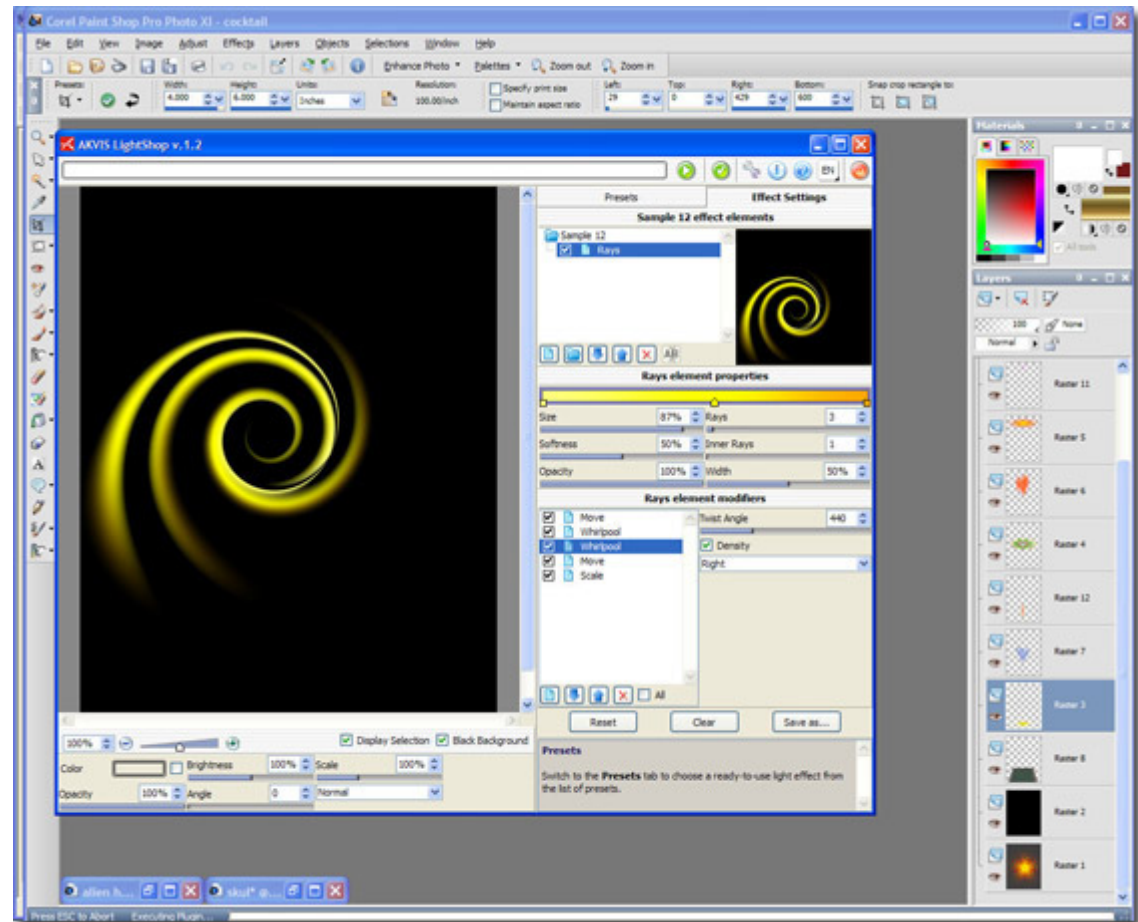

4. Change the proportions and the position of the pasted base (Fig. 4).

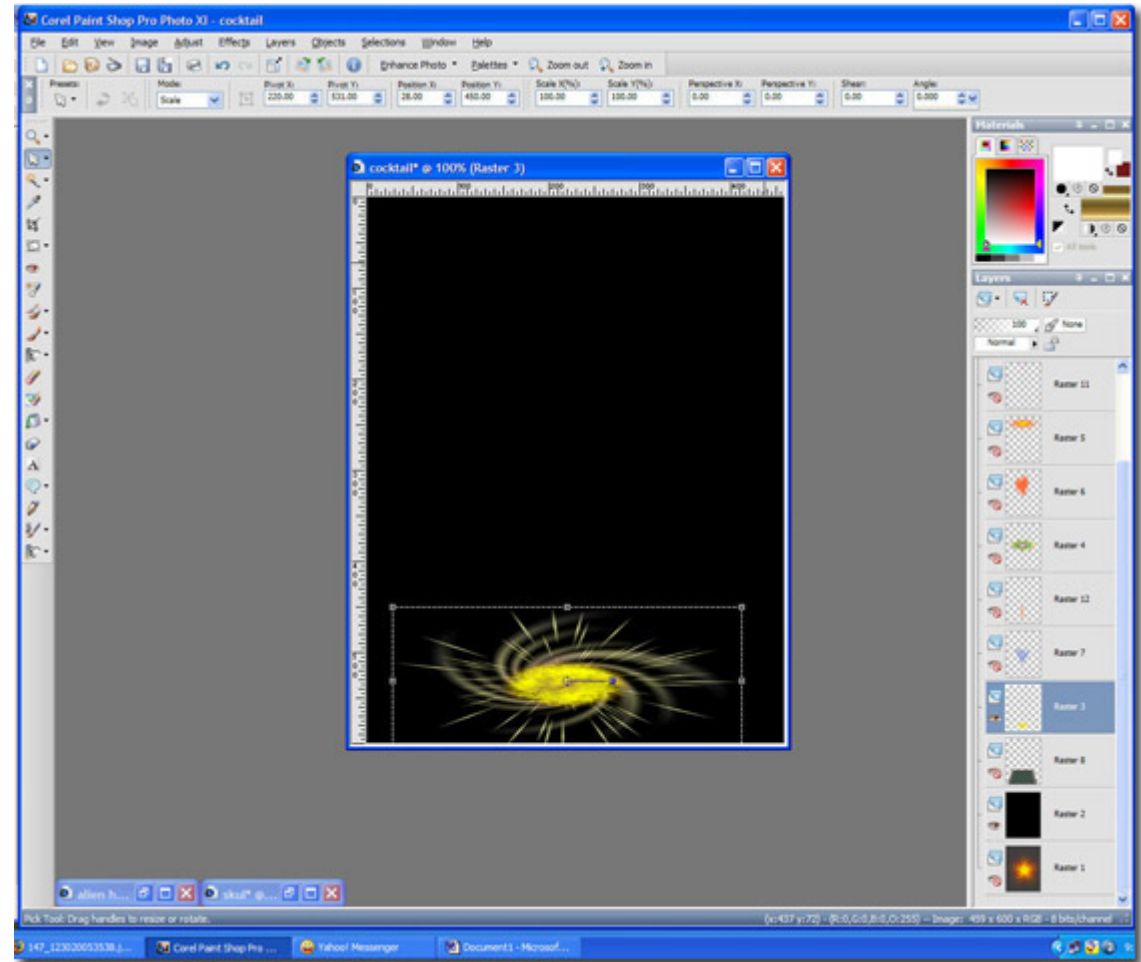

5. Now we make a stem. Call **AKVIS LightShop** again and choose **Sample 45** (Fig.

5). Change the settings and press the button .

Change the settings and apply the result by pressing the button .

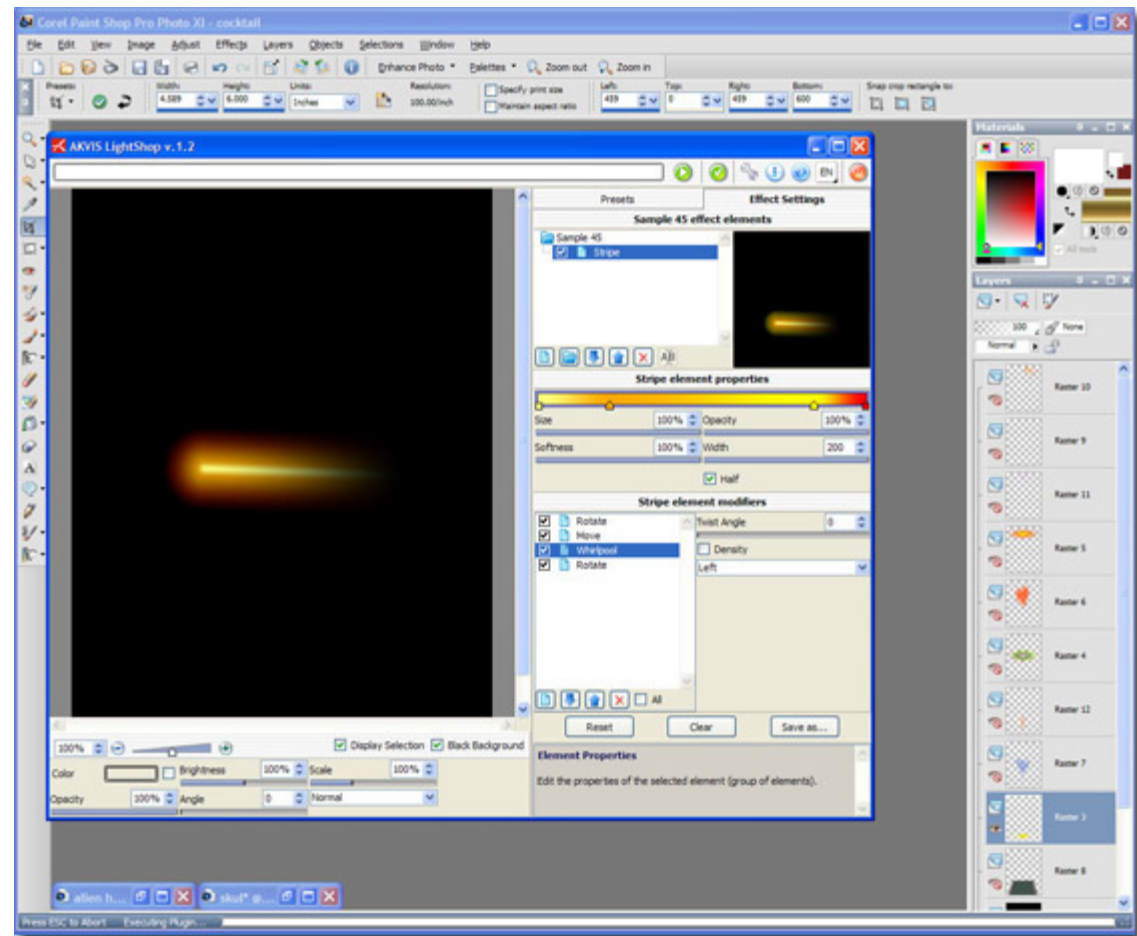

6. Now we make a tray and a glass (Fig. 6).

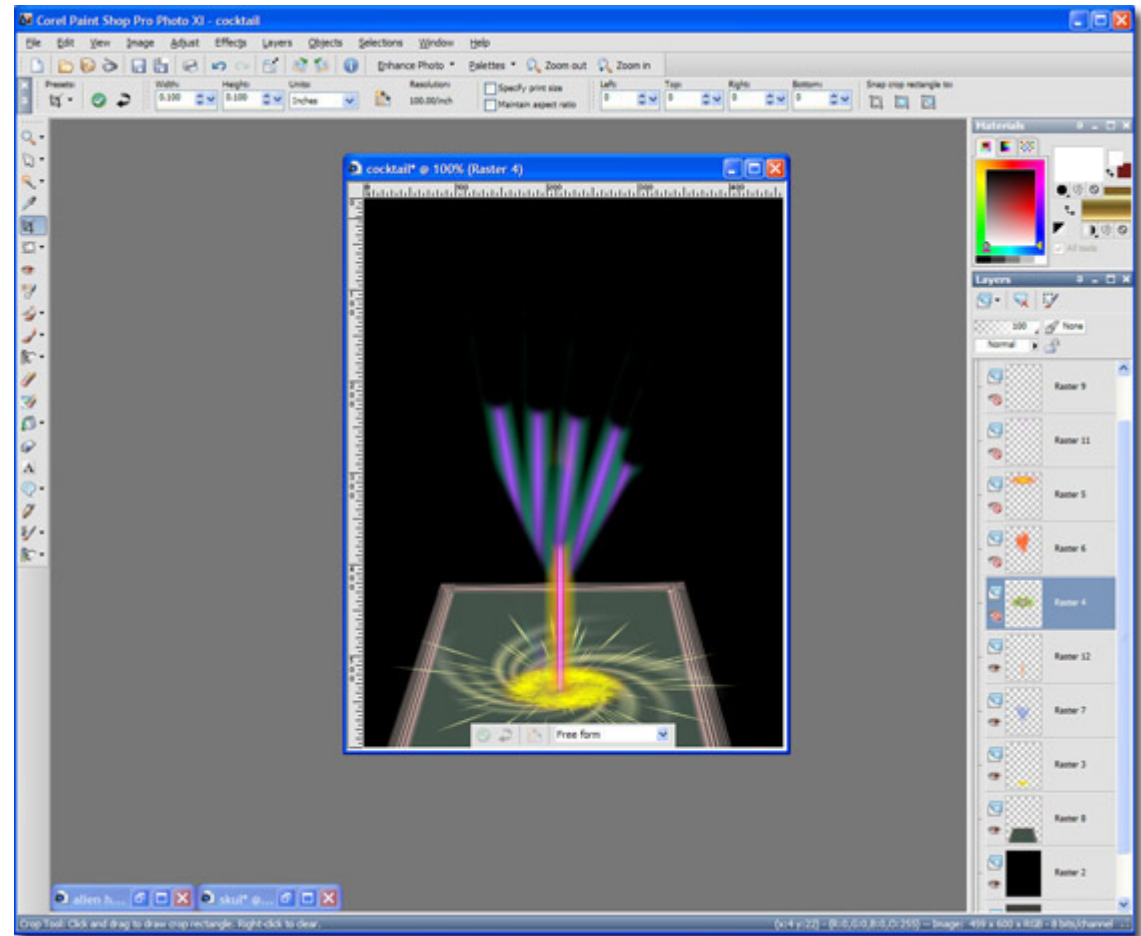

7. Decorate the glass (Fig. 7).

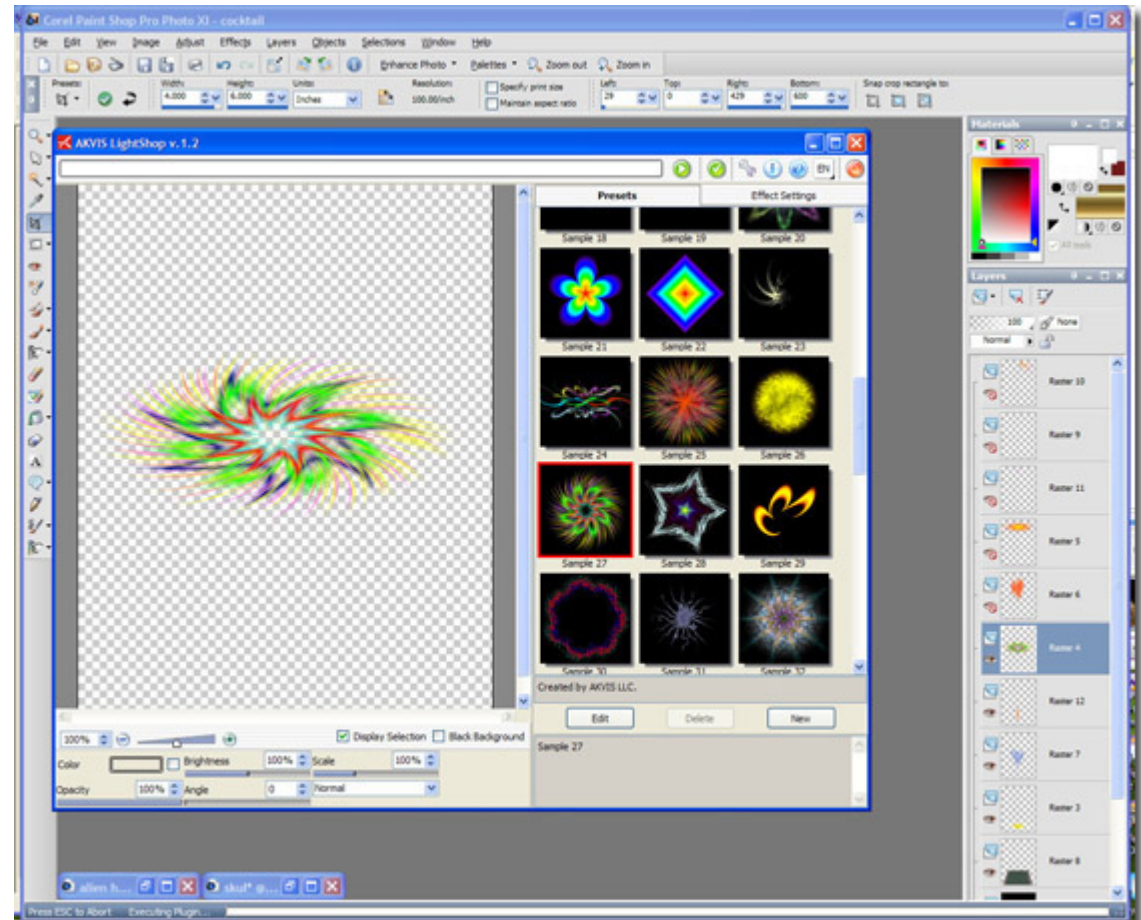

Decorate the glass body (Fig. 8).

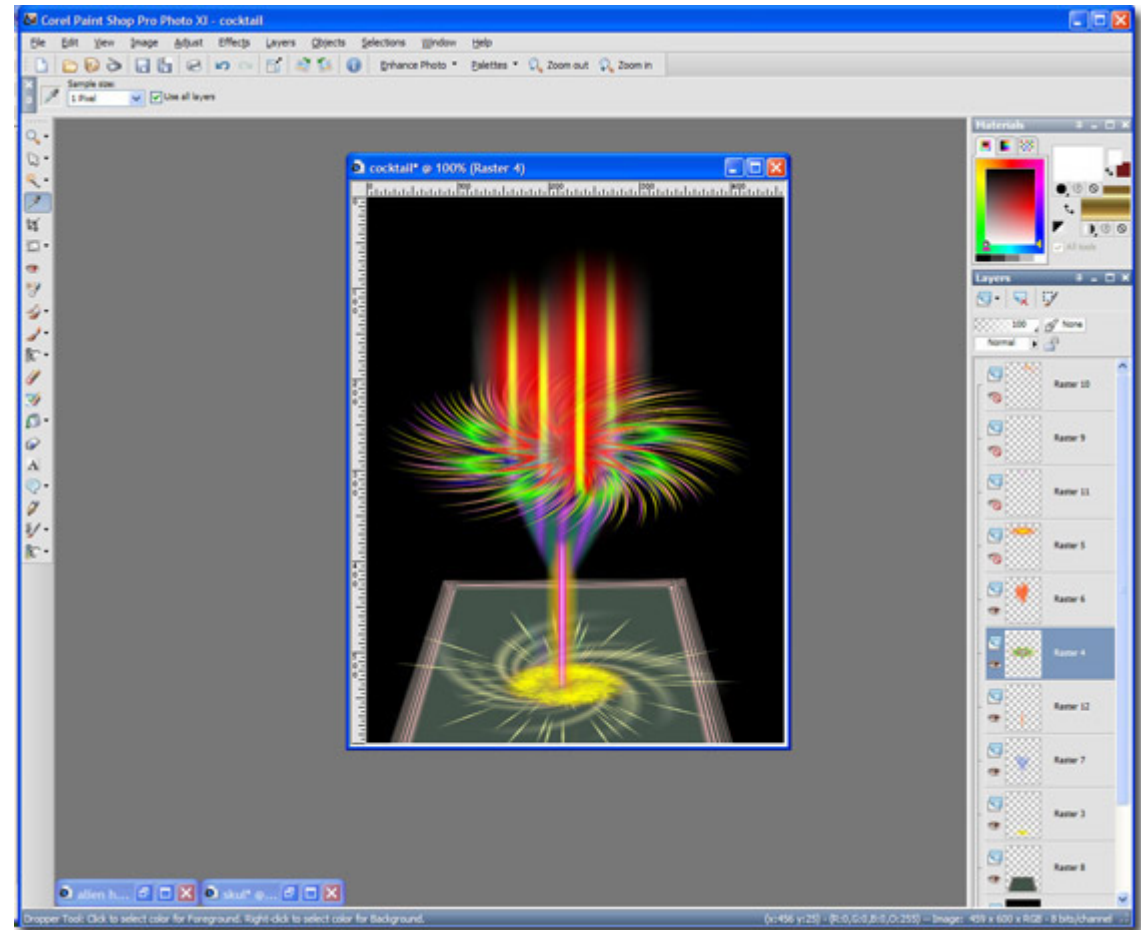

8. Add some fruits and a straw (Fig. 9) and our cocktail is ready (Fig. 10).

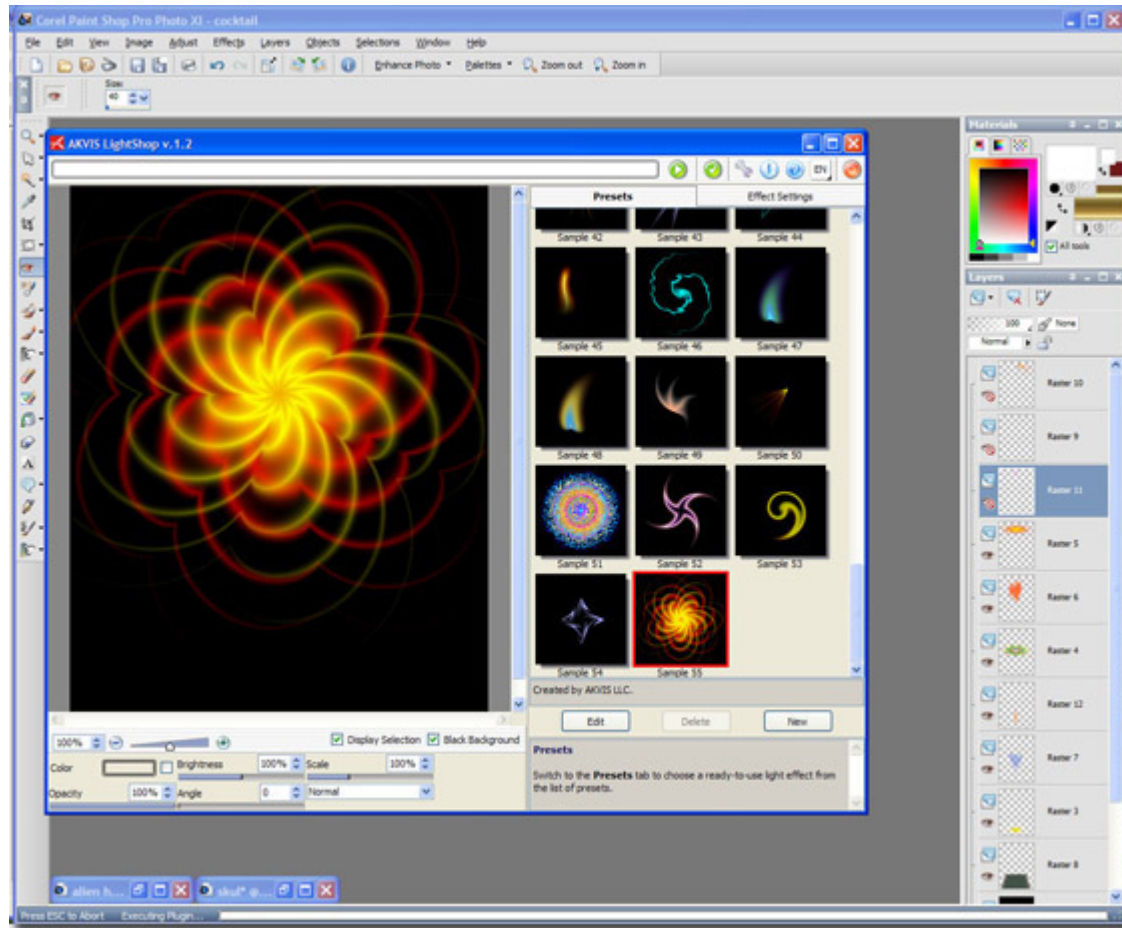

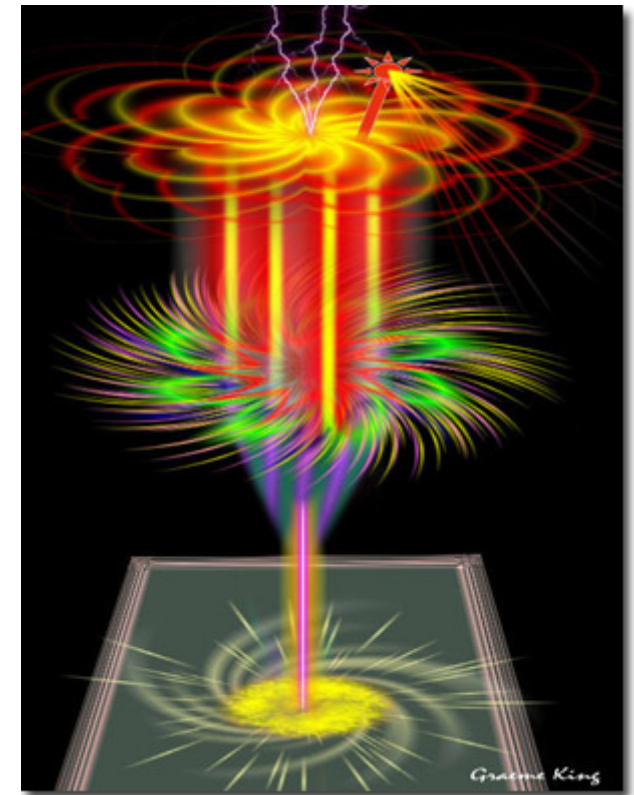
