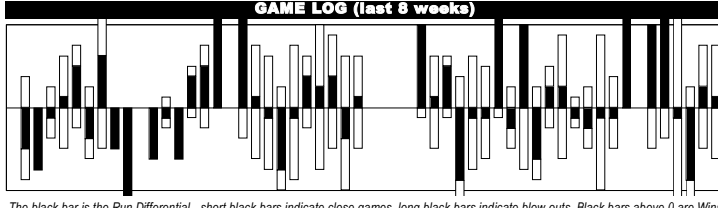

STATISTICS FOR HITTERS

Large table of statistics for hitters including AB, R, H, 2B, 3B, HR, RBI, BA, SLG, K/9, BB/9, H%, PAF, HR/9, SB, CS, Att%, Total, Hm, Rd, vs L, vs R, Positions Played, and RC.

Glossary: K/9 = strikeouts per 40 PA. BB/9 = walks per 40 PA. H% = percentage of hit balls that become hits. PAF = plate appearances per fly ball. HR/9 = home runs per 40 PA. Att% = attempted steals per trip to first base = (SB + CS) / (Singles + Walks).

STATISTICS FOR PITCHERS

Large table of statistics for pitchers including IP, W, Sv, WHIP, ERA, K, G, W, L, IP, H, R, WHIP, ERA, K, K/9, BB/9, IBB%, K/UW, H%, HR/F, Type, HR/9, GS, QS, K5, TmW, RS, IP, GR, Sv(B), Hd, BF, oppOPS vs L, vs R.

Glossary: IBB% = % of walks that are intentional. K/UW = K per unintentional walk. H% = hit rate on balls in play. QS = quality starts (6 IP or more, 3 ER or fewer). K5 = starts with five or more K. TmW = starts that team won but starter did not. RS = run

NL Reliever

For the purposes of this page, a pitcher qualifies as a reliever if he did not start a game last week.

Reverse Text indicates favorable numbers.

Main table containing player statistics for NL Relievers. Columns include Player, Team, Role, GS, SO, IP, SV, ERA, WHIP, K/9, BB/9, Type, Saves, Last Four Weeks ERA/WHIP/K/9/BB/9, Pts by Week (4/2, 4/9, 4/16, 4/23), Game State, Last Three Appearances (Game State, 1, 2, 3, BF, Dec), and Game State (1, 2, 3, BF, Dec).

Glossary: SO = Save Opportunities. Pts = calculated points (W=10, Sv=10, IP=1, K=1, ER=-1, H=-0.5, BB=-0.5). Type = GB (favoring ground balls), GBX (extreme GB), FB (favoring fly balls), FBX (extreme FB), or empty (no pronounced tendency).
