According to Arizona law, if a person or entity acquires an AED, they must have a Public Access Defibrillation (PAD) Program, with Medical Direction. The wording in the law is as follows:

Obtain, through an agreement, <u>physician oversight</u> relating to the training and use of AEDs, including training, emergency medical services coordination, protocol approval and AED deployment strategies.

Safety On Site Training offers this serivice to its clients, with much more! Our PAD Program includes:

- Medical Direction Dr. Brent Gear, DO of Paradise Valley, writes the prescriptions for our AED sales and oversees the program we developed, based on AHA recommendations. If your AED is deployed, he will be the one to read the ECG from the event to access the rescue and your AEDs performance. Safety On Site Training will then submit the necessary paperwork to the State of Arizona, which isn't required, but encouraged for the purposes of statistical tracking and improving cardiac survivability.
- Event Download Safety On Site Training will arrive on site within 24 hours of contact, following an event, to download the file. We will bring a new set of electrode pads and batteries so that your AED can be put right back into commission.
- Site Analysis Safety On Site Training will tour your site for recommendations of AED placement and quantity.
- Written Protocol A bound booklet will be customized to your site with information about your AED, what to do after an event, and a list of trained responders among other information, as required by OSHA.
- Critical Incident Stress Management A counselor will be available for any of your staff to speak with following an event, if they feel the need to talk to someone.
- Annual Site Visit Safety On Site Training will come to your site and thorough inspect your AED, check to see that monthly checks are being performed properly so that you are compliant with the law and OSHA recommendations.
- Software Upgrades On units where it's possible, when a change to CPR guidelines is made, requiring a change to the way your AED functions, Safety On Site Training will upgrade your AED at no charge.
- Newsletters We will keep you abreast of any changes in AED law, recalls and all other pertinent information.
