- 2. What was the most humorous moment in the novel for you? Does the *DELSTAR* Bank call center remind you of your own work environment?
- 3. **Handle Time** features a motley cast of characters. Which character is your favorite? Which do you find least likeable? Does any character closely resemble a person with whom you work?
- 4. The novel contains insights into many aspects of call center work life; but can you think of any office situations not included that you wished the author had addressed?
