Traditional Medicare plus Part D (prescription drug)	<ol> <li>Choose a Medicare Advantage plan with prescription drug coverage</li> </ol>	<ul> <li>Cannot choose a Medicare Advantage plan without prescription drug coverage</li> <li>Cannot choose a different Part D prescription drug plan to use with traditional Medicare coverage</li> </ul>
Traditional Medicare <u>only</u> (no Part D coverage)	<ol> <li>Choose a Medicare Advantage plan that does not include prescription drug coverage</li> </ol>	<ul> <li>Cannot choose a Medicare Advantage plan that has prescription drug coverage</li> <li>Cannot add a Part D plan to traditional Medicare</li> </ul>
