Finding the balance between achieving sustainability and investing in construction project development in the current economy is not an easy task. The good news is that the green building industry will be less affected by the down market than the traditional construction sector as homebuyers take advantage of new government incentives. In fact, according to McGraw-Hill Construction's Green Outlook 2009 expects the value of green building construction to reach \$140 billion by 2013.

The U.S. Green Building Council has made a great effort in the development of LEED Certification and the environmental advances in this sector are quite promising. Suppliers of materials, chemicals and equipment are making progress toward providing end users with the requirements to meet certifications. Several examples of companies adopting progressive environmental policies are in the news: retailers like H-E-B have set the tone by implementing LEED certification projects for their stores, as well as the Olympic Villages in Beijing, Vancouver and the zero carbon London 2012.


