WITHIN RANGE: Notes from the Chief Range Safety Officer

Those of you who are hunters and woodsmen will know this, so please bear (or deer or elk) with me.

Hypothermia is a strange thing — it's sneaky. The temperature doesn't have to be below freezing in order for one to "get" it. Hypothermia is the body's response to a falling body core temperature. Body core temp starts dropping when too much body heat is lost through the extremities. One can go hypothermic without necessarily feeling cold, because the body is already shutting down sensory pathways that don't directly support life. It affects the cognitive and sensory functions of the brain quickly, very much like carbon monoxide poisoning. And if it affects the brain first, what do you have left to gauge whether you're responsibly able to handle a firearm? This DEFINITELY falls within the "under the influence" clause of the Range Rules. PLEASE stay "Within Range" with my sincere thanks!

When on the range at this time of year, most definitely WEAR AN INSULATING CAP OR HAT. Keep that brain hot. Keep your ears, hands, and feet warm too. Keep an eye on others at the range. Signs can be subtle, but if your range-mate seems not to be as sharp as he or she was an hour ago, it's time for a warming break in the car.

Well, Old Man Winter certainly isn't in retirement this year! I've advocated scheduled range hours be closed for inclement weather, and I have sent word to our RSOs that the decision to staff the ranges in these potentially hazardous conditions be entirely his or her own, and I will back their decision 110%. (If they do choose to open the range, I'll also back them 100%, but they'd better be prepared 110% for the exposure. Shorts, socks and sandals will, ah, ahem, not get a good review.) Personally, in these cold temps, when I kiss my Kimber to give me luck on the target, I don't like my lips sticking to it.

From the looks of it, things should moderate into January, but I urge you all to have consideration for our Range Safety Officers during the cold weather. They do **incredible** service as is. They keep the ranges open for YOU. Hear me: Thank them. And thank you.
