


History of Social Security cost-of-living adjustments



Automatic cost-of-living adjustments for Social Security benefits began in 1975. From 1975-82 COLAs were effective beginning in July. Starting in 1984, COLAs were effective beginning in January. During the transition year, 1983, there was no cost-of-living adjustment.
