# sFartsED \* summer exploration

ages 6-9

**Three, two-week sessions.** Distinguished professional artists teach all Exploration sessions as children discover their own creativity by investigating a broad array of arts disciplines, including rhythms, dance, visual and theatre arts. Each day includes both structured and unstructured activities indoors and outdoors. Young participants present their new skills and creations to family and friends at a showing on the last day of each session.

**One, two-week session.** Exploring a variety of vocal musical forms including pop, musical theater and classical. This session will strengthen both the solo and ensemble singer. **One, two-week session.** Creating dance will offer classes in a variety of dance techniques as well as workshops in improvisation and composition. Emphasis will be placed on students developing their own voices as movers and choreographers. There will be a showing of the works by the students at the end of the session.

# broadway adventure

Intro • ages 9-12

**One, two-week session**. Broadway Adventure focuses on the "triple threat" skills of singing, dancing and acting for young people with interest in musical theatre performance. Students study with a performing arts faculty of professional artists and participate in a show at the end of the session.



### broadway bound

Int/Adv • ages 10-14

**One, two-week session.** Broadway Bound challenges young people with strong interest in musical theatre to further refine their performance skills. Students study with a performing arts faculty comprised of professional artists and participate in a show at the end of the session.

Session G June 29 - July 10 9a - 3p

All Levels • ages 10-14

**One, two-week session.** Students under the guidance of theater, dance and music professionals will choose and work on songs, create musical staging and dances, and find or write monologues. This session will emphasis individual expression, personal performing style and introduce audition skills. This is an excellent continuation of Broadway Bound and Adventure. There will be a showing at the end of the session.

**One, two-week session.** World Rhythms offers workshops with professional percussionists giving students a rare insight into techniques, instrumentation and perspectives from a variety of cultures. There will be a showing at the end of the session. Instruments are provided.
