01/20/2009	<u>130</u>	ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFFS MOTION FOR PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT AS TO STANDING [95, 108, 121] by Judge Stephen V. Wilson: The Court finds that Plaintiff QED did not acquire an interest in the Properties by virtue of a transfer from the bankruptcy court because any such transfer was done in violation of the automatic stay, and was therefore void as a matter of law. As factual issues potentially remain regarding whether Plaintiffs have interests in the Properties sufficient to confer standing, Plaintiffs Motion for Partial Summary Judgment on the issue of standing is DENIED. With regard to Plaintiffs alternative theory of ownership, these cases are STAYED pending the outcome of the proceedings in Colorado, which will result in Defendant SLMI-CO having a representative that is duly authorized to speak on its behalf. The parties are ordered to inform the Court, in writing, when the stay should be lifted. (Made JS-6. Case Terminated.) (pc) (Entered: 01/27/2009)
