A pioneer in the California wine industry, Concannon has a history of firsts. Our most outstanding accomplishment is the production of the first varietally labeled Petite Sirah in America from the 1961 vintage, a wine that has become our flagship.

Winemaker Notes

The 2006 Petite Sirah, Reserve is a dense, finely structured, complex wine. Plum, blackcurrant and caramel aromas on the nose lead to more dark fruits on the palate, and cinnamon and warm spices waft in the background. While ready to drink now, this wine is age-worthy and can be held for upwards of five years.

Veal chops, grilled flank steak with chimichurri sauce or your favorite wild game.
