



## DESIGNER-FURNISHED SHOWCASE HOME UNVEILED AT THE TOWER RESIDENCES AT THE RITZ-CARLTON, DALLAS

The home's two and one half bathrooms are highlighted by a stunning master bath, while an acclaimed highlight of the Robb & Stucky-furnished home is also its spacious terrace offering spectacular views of central Dallas and of the exclusive private grounds, gardens, swimming pool, whirlpool and outdoor fireplace, which are part of The Tower Residences enclave.
