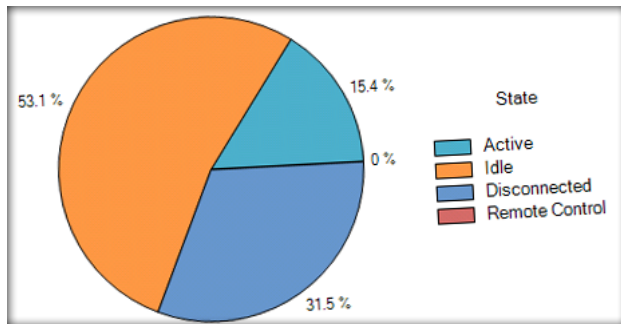
Centralized Administration via Live Dashboard

Powerful summary reports and statistics

With Terminal Services Log summary reports you will gain an important insight into activities on your server. These reports provide key statistical information that help you optimize resources for a Terminal Services / Citrix farm. You can generate reports about your Terminal Services / Citrix server or farm usage, monitor employee log on/log off times, monitor activities and do time tracking.

In-depth time reports and analysis

Time reports are easy to use allowing you to analyze activities that occurred during one day, one week or one month. You can also drill down into activities by server or session state, export reports to PDF or XLS formats. You can use these reports to monitor user activities. For instance, you can identify long periods of inactivity, monitor an individual user's activities on a Terminal Services / Citrix server, and determine total active hours for subcontractors.

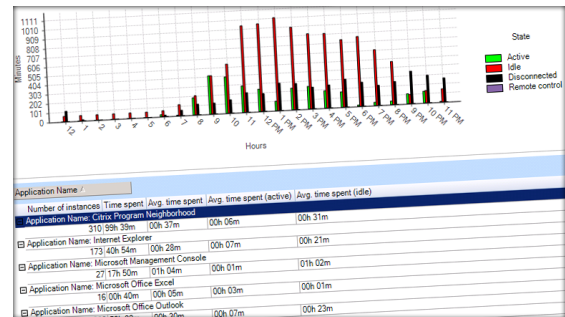

Advanced analytics (OLAP)

If you feel that built-in reports do not meet your needs, there is more... SQL Server OLAP cubes are the solution for you. With these you can build powerful custom reports straight from familiar interface of Microsoft Office Excel. You can drill into gathered data, cross-reference data from different reports, create KPI's and much more.

IP addresses and client names

Terminal Services Log now comes with a new connectivity monitoring report which allows you to see all hostname, IP addresses and network ranges. This report shows you the location of each user on your server. When combined with a server filter you can pinpoint the exact server a user is connected to.
