## **BC Technology Industry Launches Olympic Initiative**

PODIUM program to connect international guests and media to BC innovation

**Vancouver, BC, December 11, 2009** – Today, the <u>British Columbia Technology Industry Association</u> (BCTIA) launched PODIUM, a comprehensive program designed to connect guests and media of the 2010 Vancouver Olympic and Paralympic Games with potential business partners and media stories while visiting BC.
