How It Works

With Reelspark, video is easy. Direct capture records video using any browser, directly from webcams and posts automatically to profiles. Or users can capture video from their cell phones.

The camera never lies. Lifeless photos and static text messages fail to offer the intimacy and chemistry of face to face interaction. Reelspark eliminates guesswork altogether.

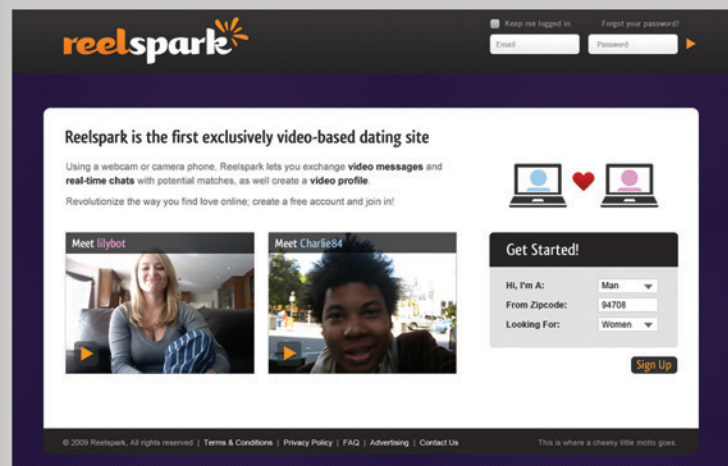
Why It Works

Online dating usually fails on account of being too mathematical; it puts too much focus on compatibility testing, quiz-taking, and comparing oddly-quantified personality charts. Often, we pour time and effort into these distractions, finally reaching that first date, only to discover that there is chemistry on paper, but not in real life. Imagine, now, if we could see and hear the people we are meeting, much like we do in person, and recognize immediately when we click. Reelspark introduces this crucially intuitive, sensory, human element to online dating. And it works.

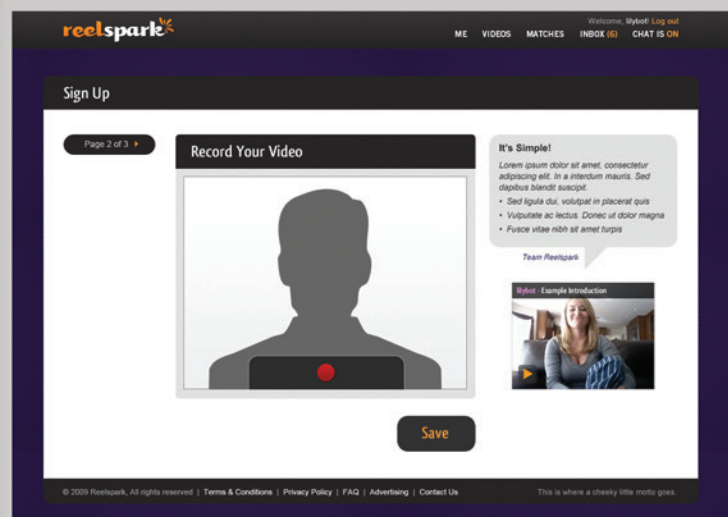
Reelspark does not have stock or bait profiles (memberships created to bolster user numbers) which are commonly used on major dating sites. eHarmony has received 1,300 complaints from the Better Business Bureau within 3 years, criticizing the use of fake profiles, even discrimination against homosexuality. Reelspark is unbiased, and welcomes any race, creed, or sexual orientation to use our site.

Reelspark is transparent and eliminates scams. We have a zero-tolerance for fraud at any level. We solve this issue with video capture. Users are prompted to capture video directly from their browsers, and since there is no option to upload doctored videos, scammer activity is nearly non-existent. All public profile videos are moderated by our management team, and the users themselves. Video capture is quick, easy, and ensures the safety and security of our community.

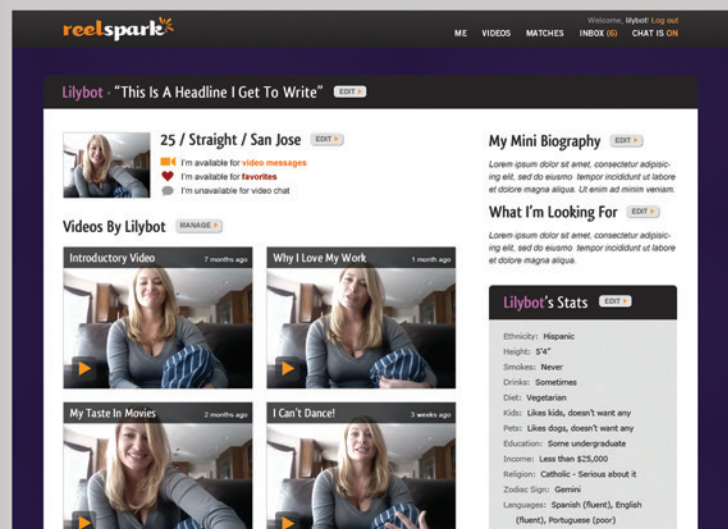

Reelspark & The Facts

Sexual orientation discrimination has long plagued the online dating industry. eHarmony was famously sued in 2007 for excluding homosexual users, and many leading services continue to block bisexuals from matching accurately.

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q** What is different about Reelspark?
- A** We are the *only* video-based dating site. There's Reelspark and there's everyone else.
- Q** What is direct capture?
- A** Direct capture uses the Adobe Flash media system to, upon your approval, directly connect your webcam with Reelspark.
- Q** Can I post videos or pictures from my hard drive?
- A** No. Reelspark only uses media captured live from your webcam or camera phone so as to make sure that it's actually you speaking, eliminating the possibility for scams.
- Q** Will I need a video camera or editing software?
- A** No. All you need is a webcam or camera phone, which we'll use to capture video from you straight to your profile or other another user's inbox. There's no editing to worry about -- just fix your hair, hit record, and talk!
- Q** How many videos are on my profile page?
- A** Silver users can capture 6 videos, while Gold users can have 12. Both, however, have access to unlimited video messaging.
- Q** How much does it cost to sign up again?
- A** There are three primary account types: Free Plan, Silver Plan for \$39.99 per 6 months, and Gold Plan for \$49.99 per 6 months. Refer to the Reelspark Plans for details.
- Q** Is my identity safe?
- A** Absolutely. We won't share an iota of your sensitive information, and your profile will only show the details you've selected for people to see. We discourage all users from revealing phone numbers, addresses, or any other contact information in their videos.
- Q** What are the rules of conduct?
- A** Reelspark monitors public videos and has a no-tolerance policy for videos depicting violence, hate speech, or sexually explicit content. We police predatory behavior, harassment, and spamming. Users have complete control over messaging settings, and are encouraged to block or flag any account that breaks the rules. Accounts that do not comply will be removed. However, Reelspark does not moderate private video-messages or web-cam chats out of respect for the privacy of our users. We will only get involved if a legitimate complaint has been issued.

Why You Should Try It

No other online dating site provides such an honest experience to their users. Our video-based system brings a much needed human element back to online dating. It presents us with a fresh option for meeting live people on an intimate level, a living experience that can't be found on static photo sites.
