The following raw materials are used in the production of Bambo Nature baby diapers:

Fluff	Peroxide-bleached (H ₂ O ₂) paper material. Does not contain optical brightener.
SAP	The SAP is a mix of wheat starch and acrylic polymers, does not contain phthalates (SAP = Superabsorber).
Non-woven	Produced from polypropylene (PP) without the use of organic solvents. Is not based on chlorine and does not contain phthalates.
Tape	Produced from paper and polyethylene (PE).
Foil	Produced from polyethylene (PE).
Lycra	Mainly consists of elastomers made from polyurethane.
Ink	The printing ink is not based on heavy-metal-containing pigments.
Glue	Does not contain phthalates, is based on resin and wax.

None of the above-mentioned raw materials used for the production of baby diapers contain MBT (Monobutyltin), DBT (Dibutyltin), TBT (Tributyltin), Cl (Chlorine) or HCHO (Formaldehyde).

Bambo Nature baby diapers contain no perfume or lotion/moisturiser in order to avoid allergic reactions. The reason is that such lotions may contain allergising agents that have only been added to prevent odour. The absorbing material in the product is fully capable of satisfying this purpose.

The Eco-label Secretariat of the Danish Environmental Protection Agency has approved all raw materials used in products labelled with "The Swan" – the official environmental label of the Nordic countries. All Bambo Nature products are labelled with "The Swan".

All raw materials are FDA-approved (Food and Drug Administration).
