During the Concert Series, it was large enough to accommodate not only the band, but a live audience as well. Connected to the big room are 5 isolation rooms/booths for isolation of a vocalist or instrument amplification, 3 of which have full view into the main/live room, making our facility ideal for live tracking of any kind.
