Not Just An Ordinary Release. INTELLIMED is pleased to announce the deployment of Build 308 to the Intelligent Client (IM-IC) application. This release is jam-packed with new features and functionality you have been requesting. This update, the third in a series of new features builds upon the upgrades that began last year with build 300. As noted with that release, our goal of increasing functionality and creating additional reporting tools has been successful, and continues with this release.

What's new in this release?

- **Pivot Tables!** This initial foray into Pivot Table reporting brings the power of ad-hoc reporting to your fingertips by providing you the ability to choose your column details, row details and table data. This report, requested by numerous customers including those looking for more ad-hoc reporting along with the standard Intellimed reports is the primary update for Build 308.
- Summarized Demographic Report! Hello Marketing, Business Development and administration users, you spoke and we listened. This report takes the best of the population, income, race and education reports (still available individually) and combines them into one, easy to read summarized picture. Want a summary of your PSA, SSA or County? Done! Done! Done! An exciting addition to the demographic reports.
- Custom Column Enhanced now "Crosstab"! Wait a second, Enhanced? Yes, Intellimed has taken the Custom Columns report to another level by allowing up to 10 groupings. This change is significant in both function and feature as the Custom Column report also allows you to choose your column labels (1) and add report matrix values underneath. Want a 10 year case volume trend, not just 3 years? The Crosstab report can do it.
- **Export Group Details!** Intellimed Groups and Custom Groups have always been available, but until 308, were not able to be exported. That's right, all Custom Groups and Intellimed Groups contents can now be exported. Simply show the details on a group and right click the highlighted section to copy and paste to your favorite program.
- Ambulatory/Inpatient Report! Those clients with access to Ambulatory data now have a revised "Ambulatory/Inpatient Report". This report provides a picture of both lines of business in a combined view while showing calculation of Inpatient & Outpatient market share.
- Reminder : Physician Overview! Don't forget to checkout the Physician Overview!

- Fixed Sg2 Chart and Data populating beyond 2008
- Fixed Export to Excel Row Count The # of rows being exported was displayed incorrectly.
- Fixed The "city" listing was not populating in all databases.
- Adjustment Added grouping options for MDC (MS-DRG) and MDC (3M-APRDRG)
- Adjustment Use Rate report properly shows population when grouped by Age Group

Intellimed will be forwarding to all users, an email that will contain the necessary instructions. The entire process should take less than 15 minutes to complete.

Answer: Yes, though it will not contain the Pivot Table, Demographic Summary, Cross-Tab, Exporting Question: Will all of my existing custom groups and saved reports be available? Answer: Yes, Absolutely, Confirmed 100% Question: Does Intellimed work in Windows Vista and Windows 7 (32/64)? Answer: Yes, IM-IC works in both 32 and 64 bit versions.
