CONTEST INFORMATION

Save the Redwoods League announces an exciting new nature art contest for kids!

K-12 students can compete for great prizes while helping Save the Redwoods League raise awareness about redwoods. Students are invited to create a postcard illustrating the thing that most inspires them about the redwood forest.

Educators, our free <u>Teacher Toolkit</u> can help you teach your students about these amazing forests — be sure to consider a field trip!

KIDS! How to Enter:

- Learn all you can about redwoods. Visit <u>SaveTheRedwoods.org</u>. Go to a local library. Visit a <u>redwood park</u> to experience these amazing trees firsthand.
- 2. Print and complete the **Entry Form** below:
 - Create a picture of the thing that most inspires you about the redwood forest — maybe an animal, plant or landscape — in the postcard-sized box. You could draw it, paint it, make a print ... use your imagination!
 - Write a short note (in the space provided) to President Obama, telling him why redwoods inspire you. The League will print all entries as postcards and mail them to the President at the end of the contest.
 - Fill out all contact information (required) and make sure your parent/guardian signs it.

Deadline:

All entries must be postmarked or handdelivered by April 30, 2010, at 5 p.m. U.S. Pacific Time.

Who is Eligible:

Any student in grades Kindergarten through 12, ages 5-18, who is a U.S. resident.

Judging:

Postcards will be judged based on creativity and how well the theme of the contest is communicated. Three (3) winners will be chosen from each of the following age groups: 5-9, 10-13 and 14-18.

Prizes:

Rules Summary:

- 1. An **Entry Form** (below) is required to enter this contest.
- 2. Students may use any two-dimensional media to create their postcard (drawing, painting, printmaking, etc.); the picture must fit inside the postcard-sized box on the Entry Form.
- 3. The message to President Obama must specifically describe the thing that most inspires the entrant about the redwoods, as illustrated on the postcard.
- 4. The postcard must be the entrant's original creation.
- 5. The design may not incorporate any copyrighted characters, nor violent or inappropriate content.
- 6. Save the Redwoods League will not return any entries.
- 7. All winners will be asked to send a photo of themselves clearly showing their faces. Names and photos of winners will be used for announcement and promotional purposes only, with parent's/guardian's permission.
- 8. The League reserves the right to use all entries in future promotional materials.
- 9. The League reserves the right to modify any entry for reproduction and promotional purposes.
- 10. The signature of a parent or legal guardian is required for all submissions by entrants under 18 years of age.
- 11. Read the Terms, Conditions and Official Rules for this contest before submitting an entry.
