MORLET WELL-KNOWN IN WINE CIPCLES



Pay attention, folks... this is one of the most exciting new lineups we've presented in some time. Thanks to our friends in the industry, we were able to gain cellar access to the Morlet collection, a tall order to be certain. Luc Morlet's reputation is well-known in wine circles. He helped put Peter Michael on the map and has worked for such properties as Newton, Staglin and Kongsgaard in Napa. In France, he can count stints in his native Champagne, Burgundy and Bordeaux on his CV. He's been around, and every stop has been the beneficiary of his talent and work.

Now intensely devoted to his own project, Luc is leveraging his grower relationships to source grapes from some of the best properties anywhere. He knows who the best farmers are and works diligently alongside his partners to produce highcaliber fruit - cost be damned. Based on what his wines

taste like and the critical praise they've been receiving, it's clear that Luc's mission statement of "quality without compromise" isn't some sort of marketing tagline. It's his winemaking mantra.

'08 "La Proportion Dorée" • Sonoma COUNTY. Absolutely stunning. This may the best Semillon-based blend from California we've ever **tried.** With no malolactic fermentation but intense lees stirring, it's a succulent blend of tangerine and lychee nut flavors with incredible depth and length. 500 cases made. 1WMOR08OW3LP.. \$59.95 btl. \$53.95 btl./mixed case

'08 "Ma Douce" Chardonnay • Sonoma **COAST.** There's almost a red fruit quality to this beauty, something reminiscent of Chassagne-Montrachet. Round and mouth-coating, this is a hedonist's Chardonnay with ripe tropical fruit, crème brûlée and seductive oak toast in perfect balance.

'08 "CÔTEAUX NOBLES" PINOT NOIR • **SONOMA COAST.** With a vineyard that's next door to Marcassin, it's no surprise our collective jaw hit the floor with the first sniff. Just superlative depth and fruit concentration with violets, cherries, a little hint of chocolate and Asian spices. Gorgeous juice. Truly a show-stopping Pinot.



'07 "BOUQUET GARNI" SYRAH • BENNETT **VALLEY.** Only 150 cases of this head-turner were made. Robert Parker found "Notes of steak tartare, tar, pepper, and lard jump from the dense purple-colored 2007 Syrah Bouquet Garni from Bennett Vineyard. It is structured, very northern Rhône-like, and clearly a cool-climate Syrah..." Very impressive work. 1WMOR07SY3BG ... \$84.95 btl. \$76.45 btl./mixed case

'07 "Mon Chevalier" Cabernet Sauvignon • KNIGHTS VALLEY. Given his work with Peter Michael's legendary "Les Pavots," the quality found here didn't surprise us. It instantly ranks among Sonoma's finest Cabernet offerings. Black fruits, blueberries and anise with long, chewy fruit tannins. A scant 175 cases produced.

Yes, the excitement surrounding the 2007 vintage in Napa Valley is wholly justified. Robert Parker wrote that this "offers a seamless introduction to this flagship cuvée. Its inky/purple color is followed by aromas of crème de cassis, incense, crushed rocks, lead pencil shavings, cedar, and spice box. It possesses a massive, opulent mouthfeel, serious tannins, and no hard edges. This stunning effort should hit its peak in 5-8 years, and last 40 years. I would not be surprised to see it become the greatest Insignia to date and close in on a perfect score." Press like that tends to

PLUMPJACK THESE WINES DELIVER



Robert Parker has praised this winery for its "consistently brilliant wines," and, as the founders of the estate have said, "PlumpJack is about demystifying the wine buying experience and removing the intimidation factor." Considering that philosophy is also the

undercurrent of Bounty Hunter, we figured we had

a pretty good fit with their overall vibe. We're also quite familiar with the work of winemaker Anthony Biagi from his Duckhorn and Paraduxx days, and the skills of cellar consultant Nils Venge from a barrelful of high-profile success stories, so it stands to reason that the wines will deliver. Deliver they do, friends. Deliver they do.

'08 "RESERVE" CHARDONNAY • NAPA

VALLEY. Like 'em ripe and saucy? We've got you covered. Texturally outsized with banana, pineapple and white peach flavors, **it still brings a ballerina's balance** with fresh acidity through the mid-palate. Here's bottled proof that flavor needn't come at the expense of style points.

'O7 MERLOT • NAPA VALLEY. This is going to recalibrate your worldview if you think great Merlot can't go toe-to-toe with Cabernet. Robert Parker noted that the '07 "boasts a dense purple color as well as a gorgeously sweet perfume of white chocolate, coffee beans, plums, black currants, and a hint of mocha. Full-bodied and dense with layers of fruit and glycerin as well as a sumptuous texture..." This is a can't-miss vintage for Napa reds...



'07 "ESTATE" CABERNET SAUVIGNON • NAPA VALLEY. Take it away, Mr. Parker! "Floral notes intermixed with crème de cassis, white chocolate, plum, and licorice characteristics are followed by a wine with supple tannins, fabulous concentration, a multilayered mouthfeel,

tannins, fabulous concentration, a multilayered mouthfeel, and a finish that lasts 40+ seconds. This incredible Cabernet can be drunk now or cellared for 20-25 years." **Warning issued... step up while it's still around.**

CADE IMPRESSIVE OFFERINGS



PlumpJack's sister winery Cade has been all over the press of late. Hailed as one of the "greenest" wineries ever built, its perch on Howell Mountain provides the sort of views that make people lose all sense of reason and start figuring out how

to move to Napa Valley. But make no mistake... this isn't about being a mere showpiece property. Robert Parker

noted, "As one might expect, given the quality of the PlumpJack wines, the Cade offerings are serious." Winemakers Tony Biagi and Nils Venge are afforded access to the sort of vineyards that make great stuff. Frankly, we'd be shocked if the wines didn't continue to impress the critics (and us). Keep close tabs on this new leader in both cutting-edge design and sustainable winemaking philosophy.

'09 Sauvignon Blanc • Napa Valley.

Fattened up through the mid-palate with the addition of some seductive Semillon, this could pass for a ripe Graves. Guava, fresh grass and mineral flavors (with just a hint of lees) beg for some Cajun shrimp on the grill. It'll also keep the chef happy in the process.

'06 CABERNET SAUVIGNON • HOWELL MOUNTAIN. A muscle-bound effort from one of Napa's most acclaimed Cabernet sub-districts, this will get fans of "big reds" in a tizzy. Robert Parker noted that it "reveals excellent potential. It possesses high acids, high tannin, and, as most mountain Cabernets do, requires some bottle age." Black fruits, pencil lead and barrel char with the minerality that makes Howell Mountain Cab a unique breed.

'07 "ESTATE" CABERNET SAUVIGNON •
HOWELL MOUNTAIN. Hello! Can you say "rock star?" Robert Parker reviewed this as "Absolutely sensational... It reveals a strikingly provocative aromatic display of blue and black fruits, crushed rocks, violets, and a hint of chocolate. This full-bodied, dense, classic mountain Cabernet Sauvignon is built for long-term aging... awesome concentration and texture..." Very limited availability.

Paul and Suzie Frank released their first wine, the 1997 vintage, from the Gemstone Vineyard in Yountville, and it quickly rocketed to must-have, "cult wine" status (Wine Spectator noted that they "rode a string of great Cabernet vintages to join Napa Valley's elite wine producers.") Based on their critical success and subsequent consumer following, the Franks were often approached with purchase offers, but never found the right caretakers to their dream until Michael and Carole Marks stepped into the picture. Having assured Paul and Suzie of their commitment to the original vision of the estate – and continuity of the immensely talented Philippe Melka's hand in the cellar – the Franks were able to hand over the reigns knowing that the property



would be taken beyond even what had already been accomplished. Continue to expect "great stuff" from this remarkable property.

'07 "FACETS OF GEMSTONE" • NAPA VALLEY.

Robert Parker was direct in his praise, calling Facets "one of the finest second labels in Napa." He went on to add that the '07 "offers abundant amounts of sweet black cherry and black currant fruit intertwined with soil and underbrush undertones. It also reveals the opulence and fleshiness of this vintage." A serious bargain given its pedigree.

'06 GEMSTONE "TEN" • NAPA VALLEY.

Celebrating the 10th release of the vineyard's flagship, this also got the attention of Mr. Parker in a big way: "It exhibits a dense ruby/purple color as well as a beautiful bouquet of subtle new oak interwoven with black currants, smoke, licorice, and a hint of spring flowers. The wine is full-bodied, with excellent density, admirable balance, and fine purity, a hallmark of this estate." Very little of this wine makes it outside of top restaurants. Limited availability...

OAKVILLE PEDIGREE TASTE OF TO KALON

Simply one of the finest Cabernet sites in the New World.

Andy Beckstoffer's portion of the historic To Kalon property in Oakville is home to 100-point wines, universal respect and one of the most talented and dedicated vineyard management teams on the planet. It is simply one of the finest Cabernet sites in the New World. *Wine Spectator* has called the property "Napa's Cab Central" and Robert Parker regularly rewards wines born in To Kalon with his loftiest reviews. There's no mistaking the history and pedigree of this grand Oakville vineyard.

We've assembled three interpretations of To Kalon magic for your consideration.

Yes, we're biased (Jurisprudence is one of our own), but there's no way we'd fork over the kind of coin that its fruit fetches without **the utmost belief in the end result.** You'll see degrees of variation where winemaking comes into play, but the common vein that runs through them is undeniably To Kalon.

KALON" CABERNET SAUVIGNON • OAKVILLE. A debut release and cousin to our highly-rated "Justice Series" trio, this is a very serious expression of To Kalon fruit. Creamy black cherry and mocha notes are topped with a dollop of cherry liqueur in one of the finest values to emerge from the vineyard.

'07 ALPHA-OMEGA "BECKSTOFFER TO



KALON" CABERNET SAUVIGNON • NAPA VALLEY. An exceptionally rare treat from this rising-star producer, this is pure Oakville. Cassis and black fruits, sexy flecks of toffee and espresso and a finish you can time with an hourglass. 250 cases made.

'07 TOR KENWARD "BECKSTOFFER TO



KALON" CABERNET SAUVIGNON • OAKVILLE. Longtime Napa insider Tor Kenward has been on a tear with the critics lately. Robert Parker hailed this release for its "abundant aromas of crème de

cassis, licorice, cedar, spice box, and a whiff of unsmoked, high class cigar tobacco. With a full-bodied palate as well as a beautiful texture, richness, moderately high tannins, and admirable purity and length."

We're not sure why finding truly delicious white wine at bargain prices is so difficult, but a wade through the Streamside should convince you that this is where you should cast your fly.

'08 PINOT GRIGIO • CALIFORNIA. OK, we heard you! Find a delicious Pinot Grigio with actual complexity for not a lot of dough. Aromas of melon and fresh cut hay with the clean lines that can only come from being raised entirely in stainless steel. We can't keep this in stock at our wine bar.

'09 RIESLING • SANTA LUCIA

HIGHLANDS. Boy, did we have fun making this! Stopping fermentation with just a little residual sugar, it reminds us of a ripe German Kabinett. Honeyed fruit notes of cantaloupe and lime with a balance of sugar and acid rare in New World Riesling. Only 100 cases made.

BELLE GLOS THEIR BEST LINEUP FUER



We've been telling anyone within earshot that some special things are afoot at Belle Glos, and you know what? We think this is their best lineup ever. Joseph Wagner (his family owns Napa's legendary Caymus Vineyards) focuses his talents on Pinot Noir with an emphasis on single-vineyard selections. He farms them to suit his goals in the cellar which are

full-throttle, "steakhouse Pinots" that have the

body and extraction to impress even ardent Cabernet fans. These wines are not for the faint of heart, but if rich, juicy, thoroughly delicious Pinot Noir sounds like your kind of party, consider this your formal invitation.

'08 "CLARK & TELEPHONE" PINOT NOIR • SANTA MARIA VALLEY. Planted to one of the oldest own-rooted Pinot vineyards in California (1972), this is darker than a Coen brothers movie with black cherry, rhubarb and intense spice bass notes. Fantastic weight and texture.


MAKING WINE ON THEIR OWN TERMS NICKEL & NICKEL

The Nickel & Nickel project has captivated us since its inception by its scope and ambition. Producing more than 25 single-vineyard, single-varietal releases that are grown, fermented and aged as separate and individual wines is a daunting logistical challenge. It starts with the right fruit, of course, which explains the wide net they've cast in enlisting the best sources. It also helps to have dedicated growers and winemakers with an eye for the right dirt. Working with guys like Andy Beckstoffer on the vineyard side and Tim Milos in the cellar, we're fortunate to be able to include serious talent
