

The Asian Development Bank has forecast that Vietnam's GDP growth rate in 2010 will stand at 4.5%, the **highest** among Southeast Asian countries, and much higher compared to the average GDP growth of the region of 0.7%.

Ho Chin Minh City's Master Plan looks at upgrading the municipal traffic infrastructure, by developing elevated railway and metro lines and building 19 bridges spanning the Dong Nai, Saigon, Nha Be, Long Tau and Thi Vai rivers, to relieve the city's current overloaded traffic system.




