flu season is here

Flu season is well underway, and this year it's characterized by both seasonal flu and a new virus, the H1N1 (swine) flu. Seasonal flu kills tens of thousands of people in the U.S. each year and significantly disrupts the lives of many more. The most basic personal protection is the best way to protect youself and your family: wash your hands frequently (with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer); keep your hands away from your eyes, nose, and mouth; cough/sneeze into your sleeve; stay home if you're sick; and if you haven't gotten your flu vaccine, it's not too late! Getting your flu shot now can protect you from late season outbreaks.

If you get the flu, do not go to school, work, or other public places where you will expose others to your illness. Do call your doctor or the hospital if you feel you cannot manage your symptoms at home, are pregnant, have a chronic health condition, or you feel you have developed complications (such as dehydration or difficulty breathing). National Heart Awareness Month


What better time to remind you that heart disease is the leading cause of death in men **and** women in the U.S. Offering year-round cardiac care are Aspen Valley Hospital's (AVH) board-certified cardiologists Gordon Gerson, MD, FACC, and Morris Cohen, MD, FACC.

Located on the AVH campus, Aspen Cardiology serves locals and visitors, both for routine and emergency visits. The cardiology clinic focuses on preventive care, diagnosis (including CT angiograms, echocardiograms, Doppler studies, nuclear stress tests, TEE, and Tilt Table testing), and treatment. In addition to routine follow-up care and cholesterol monitoring, a Coumadin clinic offers lab testing and adjustments to the Coumadin dose. What's more, Dr. Gerson performs device interrogation for patients with a pacemaker or defibrillator.

For patients recuperating from cardiac surgery or a cardiac event, AVH offers a comprehensive cardiac rehabilitation program in both Aspen and Basalt. Dr. Gerson has regular office hours at AVH, and he and Dr. Cohen are on call for emergencies and hospital consultations. To make an appointment about your heart health, call **970.544.7388**.

A commitment to the mid-valley

Aspen Valley Hospital's commitment to serve those who live beyond the boundaries of Aspen and Snowmass Village is long-standing. Physicians — family medicine, internal medicine, orthopedics, pediatrics, obstetrics/gynecology, pain management, and ENT — along with laboratory, diagnostic imaging (X-ray and MRI), and an ambulatory surgery center have helped meet the healthcare needs of the mid-valley community for many years.

In addition, After-Hours Medical Care opened its doors last year and offers a broad spectrum of care. Located at 234 Cody Lane in Basalt, After-Hours Medical Care is open evenings and weekends, times when your doctor's office is typically closed. Providing an alternative to a run to the emergency room, the clinic welcomes walk-ins and serves infants, children, adults, and seniors for a variety of ailments ranging from colds and flu to asthma, sprains, strains, and urinary tract infections. Staff includes family medicine physicians, registered nurses, and X-ray technologists.

Web-based medical records


Aspen Valley Hospital is part of a health information exchange network which allows doctors, hospitals, and other healthcare agencies to share and access vital medical information. The system is made possible through a partnership with the Aspen Valley Medical Foundation and Quality Health Network. With better communication among providers, patient care is more efficient, accurate, and of higher quality. Fewer medical errors, less duplication of tests, and more timely access to test results are just a few of the benefits of the system.

There are three primary objectives of the network: to assist patients in receiving optimal health status, to improve provider access to patient information, and to eliminate errors and reduce redundancies.

Data is collected into the system and subsequently distributed, pursuant to patient privacy and security standards, to providers of record involved in the patient's care. The web-based system provides a single portal for physicians to access data about their patients and includes medical histories, laboratory results, emergency room notes, medications, discharge summaries, progress notes, radiology reports, and surgical notes.

Early detection and prevention

In addition to caring for you during sickness or injury, Aspen Valley Hospital (AVH) is committed to helping you stay well. That's why we offer several health fairs each year: in the spring at AVH, in the fall at AVH for those 60 and older, and in the mid-valley in the fall. AVH health fairs provide free and low-cost screenings for common health issues — many of which are asymptomatic and treatable. With early intervention, serious health problems can often be prevented.

A typical slate of screenings at an AVH health fair includes: laboratory tests for readings on lipid levels, blood sugar, kidney and liver function, blood count, thyroid stimulating hormone, and prostate specific antigen; blood pressure; vision and glaucoma; knee exams; skin checks; peak air flow; pulse oximetry; body mass index; and immunizations. Participants are asked to consult with their primary care provider for results interpretation and follow-up on any abnormal findings.

Where families are born ...

The Aspen Birth Center occupies a new wing of the hospital. While the obstetrical unit has for many years featured personalized care and extensive guidance to new parents, the facility itself now makes this experience-of-a-lifetime even better.

The Birth Center has a total of nine patient rooms — all single occupancy — with designations for labor/delivery/recovery and postpartum care. A family waiting area, patient education classroom, large nursery with isolation area, and antepartum room for patient observation prior to active labor complete the center. Therapeutic whirlpool tubs, music, and lighting help mom to relax, and anesthesia is available at any time of the day or night. Childbirth preparation classes are offered on a frequent basis, and lactation experts help with breast-feeding after delivery.

On our medical staff are obstetrician/gynecologists Melinda Nagle, MD, and Natasha Knight, MD, as well as nurse midwife Nancy Bacheldor, CNM.



Cancer care

We know that when it comes to cancer, people want a quick and accurate diagnosis, information about their best treatment options, and the support of their family, friends, and healthcare providers. That's why Aspen Valley Hospital (AVH) is affiliated with two leading Colorado cancer centers: Shaw Regional Cancer Center in Edwards, and Invision Sally Jobe in Denver. In addition, oncologist Doug Rovira, MD, has a full-time presence in the valley with clinics at AVH on a weekly basis.

The only radiation center in the high country, Shaw employs a board-certified radiation oncologist, pharmacist, and geneticist, all of whom are available to AVH patients. They also benefit from Shaw's many other services including: PET/CT scanning, a personalized wellness program, lodging for Shaw patients and families, and an affiliation with the University of Colorado.

Invision Sally Jobe is a practice of highly specialized radiologists providing outpatient imaging services. One focus of its affiliation with AVH is the growing drive to prevent breast cancer, including early screening for women with a higher disease risk.


