Dove Missions celebrates an exciting year of accomplishments with over 200 volunteers sharing their time, talents and donations. Through our strong support system, Dove Missions:

- Helped the orphanage for girls, hospital, and two homes for disabled children, Mustard Seed and Casa Nazarete.
- Painted houses, rebuilt schools and bought 50 children school uniforms and supplies.
- Provided education, food, clean water, clothes, medicine, pampers and formula to hundreds of desperately poor children and families.
- Renovated space into our new Vocational and Recreational center for over 80 enrolled children
- Created 6 new main programs: Library and Computer Lab, Sports and Recreation Center, Health and Wellness, Art and Theater, Learning Center, Vocational Training.

Another goal of our emergency relief program is to raise funds for improving the homes in the region. Visiting volunteers lend the manpower to build up the homes giving the families a safe shelter during bad weather.



Music Program

We have many exciting programs starting this new year and our music program is one of them. When the children hear music, they light up, dancing and singing to the tunes. The music program includes teaching all construction, tools, transportation to local hotels for performances and instruction provided by a local music teacher originally from Brazil. In the first few months under the guidance of the music teacher, the older boys will construct instruments from recycled materials, milk cans, PVC tube, water jugs, bamboo, etc. In the following 4 months, our older kids will form a band. Some will play, some will sing, and some will dance. They will be writing their own songs and their own music with the intent of producing a CD. The music will be that good!

We are seeking donations to cover the hefty program cost of \$600.00 per month for a 6-month program. Once we receive enough donations to cover the whole program, we will start the program.

The children are so excited, and with the recording of the CD, all our sponsors will have an opportunity to hear their donation in action!
