Basic Nurse Assistant (BNA) Program

Students learn the necessary skills to properly care for patients in a state-certified program with a combination of 80 hours of theory and 40 hours of clinical experience. The program covers interpersonal skills, medical terminology, legal and ethical responsibilities, safe and efficient work practices, infection control, mobility and positioning, data collection, gerontology, nutrition, pre-facilitated therapy and health and safety precautions. During clinical experience, students will work directly with patients at a clinical site under supervision of the clinical instructor.

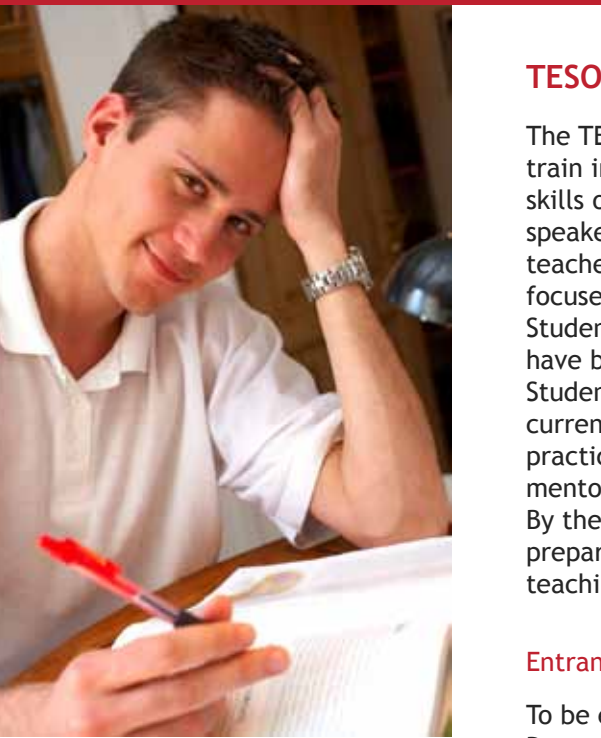
