
About Music Forte

Greg Percifield - Owner/Founder and CEO



Greg Percifield's diverse career in the music industry led him half-way around the world and back... but without his experience and dedication, Music Forte would simply not exist as the Indie Music powerhouse it is today. While taking classes at Columbia College in Chicago, IL, Greg began his musical career as the musical director for several Chicago-based theater companies. He then served as the rehearsal pianist for Cameron Mackintosh's first national U. S. Tour of 'Miss Saigon'. After earning his degree in Jazz Piano Performance, Greg then worked in sales for Yamaha pianos by day and Chicago's legendary 'Jazz Showcase' by night.

Greg had also long been drawn to the Japanese language and culture, and in 1995 he jumped at the chance when he had the opportunity to work in Japan as a musician and instructor. For the next eight years, he rooted himself deeply into the Japanese entertainment industry gaining a wealth of experience in television, film, modeling, theater, and of course, music. Greg performed regularly with his band in Osaka, Hamamatsu, and Tokyo while beginning to shift his focus to his new passion of internet business and database management.

By the time Greg returned to the Chicagoland area in 2003, he was well skilled in various forms of website development. He quickly teamed up with David Werba to build a core group of musicians and fans, and to lay the groundwork that would become MusicForte.com. Greg continues today with unwavering force as Music Forte's CEO.

After 6 months of research online in 2002, David Werba founded a marketing newsletter (O. W.L) that grew to 60,000+ subscribers within 2 months. Four years later, after working closely with business owners and consumers in nearly every English-speaking country in the world, the newsletter had grown to just over 7 million subscribers. During this time David also began developing various different e-commerce websites, ultimately having to close down his newsletter to better focus his efforts.

MusicForte.com, the website David chose to become both an owner and founder of with Greg Percifield in 2003,

marries his passion and experience of online business with his past career in music. After graduating from the University of Illinois in 1995 (Psychology/Art), David began a successful 8-year long career as the lead guitarist/composer in 5 notable Midwestern bands with the varying genres of Jazz, Blues, Rock, Pop, Folk, Alternative, and Comedy. This musical journey led him on tours to the farthest corners of the country a few times over, and even set him on an international path of discovery with most of his time being spent near Sydney, Australia.

Becoming a multi-instrumentalist over the years, David eventually retired from live performance and released 2 self-produced albums under the name 'Mr. Rose' while transitioning into his career online. Presently David establishes his office and home base near Phoenix, AZ, continuing his efforts on the development of 'Music Forte, Inc.', the production of Music Forte's new television series, and a refined list of start-up ventures. He also continues to critique and review bands, artists, music gear, technology, and gadgets - podcasting and writing in the same unique style he became known for as a songwriter and performer.
