Boys & Girls Clubs of Chicago

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Chicago (BGCC) faced a major challenge in maintaining attendance data. With 31 locations serving 17,000 youths in Head Start, after-school, and after-school daycare programs, BGCC needs detailed records for internal evaluations and grant preparation. Managers have automated the process with KidTrax, which includes bar-coded ID cards to capture attendance data electronically and uses the data for analysis and reporting purposes. This data has helped BGCC retain existing funding as well as attract new grants. "TraxSolutions (KidTrax) plays a direct, or an indirect, role in every dollar we secure," says BGCC Senior VP of Operations Dennis Chudoba.

ICAN

As an organization providing research-based after-school programs to youth, ICAN relies heavily on tracking participants and program data. ICAN has expanded by 280 percent in the past five years. Ventura Police Activities League

Until 2003, the Westpark Community Center in Ventura, California, had no adequate way to track participant attendance or facility usage. The youth center used sign-in sheets, but had no member database, and no way to gather reliable data for internal management purposes or to support their fundraising efforts. Today, Westpark uses TraxSolutions (KidTrax) to automate these processes, capturing attendance information electronically and producing comprehensive usage and demographic reports with a few clicks. This change has equipped management with concrete data that is used for program analysis, saves hours of time in grant preparation, and ensures a level of accuracy and accountability that supports funding requests.

United Way of Massachusetts Bay and Merrimack Valley

The United Way of Massachusetts Bay and Merrimack Valley funded a National Institute of Out-of-School Time (NIOST) Afterschool Program Assessment System (APAS) pilot project, which began in October 2007.
