



Residential Fire Sprinklers 1-day Training in Pennsylvania

October 13th - Horsham, PA or November 3rd - Bird in Hand, PA

The 2009 International Residential Code (IRC) has been adopted in Pennsylvania with requirements to provide fire sprinkler systems in new homes effective January 1, 2011. This creates an incredible opportunity for plumbing contractors to enter this exciting new market. This one day seminar will educate participants on the NFPA 13D and IRC P2904 requirements for designing and installing fire sprinklers in one and two family homes, including townhomes. Participants will learn about how IRC P2904 applies to multipurpose residential sprinkler systems and have a chapter-by-chapter discussion on the NFPA 13D standard to gain an understanding of water supply requirements, system layout options, system component requirements and installation tips and best practices for residential fire sprinkler systems. This training qualifies for 7 CEC hours as recognized by the PA Department of Labor and Industry.

NFPA 13D Standard

This training will involve extensive use of the NFPA 13D Standard. Each course participant should bring their own copy of the NFPA 13D Standard (not included in registration fee). You may purchase this directly from NFPA prior to the training event or on location when you arrive at the training facility.

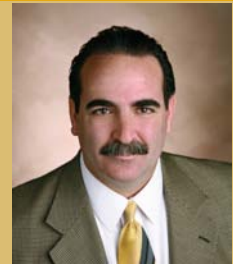
