- To ensure that you and the owner / manager of the vacation rental are on the same page, get a copy of the rental agreement before you make any payments for your trip.
- Make all payments on time. Late payments could mean a cancellation of your reservation.
- If you plan to fly, make sure to give yourself plenty of time to arrange for proper transportation.
