How To Compare Moving Companies For Your Needs

Setting up a new home in a new place can be both an exciting and a daunting task. These items are considerably more fragile and may require [movers](#) with specialized equipment or increased insurance.

There are also many other questions you may need answered about your mover's services. It may be important for you to know if the [movers](#) are bonded or bondable, particularly if you are

The disadvantages, of course, are that self-[moving](#) takes a [lot](#) of [time](#) and energy. It is also physically demanding. One person alone usually cannot manage it, especially if there are heavy furnitures that must be moved.

Another [moving](#) services option is known as self service [moving](#). In self service [moving](#), a [moving](#) company delivers a pod or crate to your home. You pack all of your belongings and load them into the crate. You then notify the [moving](#) company, who transports the crate to your new residence. You are responsible for unloading and unpacking your things. This saves you the trouble of having to drive a [moving](#) truck or a van, but you are still the one providing

all the physical labor of packing and loading. Like [moving](#) completely by yourself, self service [moving](#) is only a viable option if you have friends or family who can help you move.

Another popular [moving](#) services option is hiring the [moving](#) company to load, transport, and unload your belongings. You take responsibility for packing your household goods into boxes and unpacking them when they have reached your new location. You can often obtain boxes and other packing supplies from the [moving](#) company at little or no additional cost; alternatively, you may locate your own boxes or purchase ready-to-assemble boxes from office supply shops.

This limited-service [moving](#) option allows you to arrange your own belongings so that you can be sure that fragile items are carefully packaged and that the boxes are labeled and sorted to your satisfaction. It still requires [time](#), energy, and a certain amount of physical labor, but at least you are spared the effort of having to load and unload heavy boxes and furniture.

A final type of [moving](#) services is called full service [moving](#). If you arrange for full service [moving](#), the [movers](#) will come to your home, pack up all of your belongings, load them onto the truck or van, transport them to the new location, unload them, and unpack them. Full service [moving](#) can be especially convenient if you are physically unable to handle the exertion of packing, if you have a full schedule and don't have [time](#) to pack, or if you are [moving](#) out of town or out of the country.

No matter which type of service you choose, it is important to select your mover carefully. You should only work with [moving](#) companies that are licensed and insured by the U. S. Department of Transportation. Movers should be able to provide a motor carrier license number. It's also a good idea to check with your local Better [Business](#) Bureau to make sure there are no complaints against the company you plan to use, and to ask the company for references. Finally, to avoid misunderstandings about cost, be sure to tell the [moving](#) company exactly which services you want and what type of items they will be [moving](#). This will enable them to give you an accurate estimate.

Bureau

Drawers

Avoid overloading items in a drawer to prevent it from damaging. Take away firearms (if any) that can either break or leak. It would be better if you get items like firearms registered with their serial numbers with your van line representative before you make the move.

Cars

and

Motorcycles

If you are [moving](#) a motor vehicle like car or motorcycle on the van, make sure they are well drained off for the fuel and are emptied before the move. The batteries of motorcycles should also be removed off the connection. There should be an arrangement of automobile antifreeze done to protect your vehicles on the [moving](#) van from severe cold during winter.

Clocks

If you have a large clock with a pendulum, it is better to remove it off from it and keep it aside at a safer place. Any grandfather clocks must be moved with the help of servicemen.

Curtains

and

Drapes

You can hang drapes over crossbars in your wardrobe cartons, or you may also fold your curtains and pack them in clean cartons. Alternatively, you may remove the curtains from rods, fold them and pack them in either cartons or bureau drawers.

Lamps

and

Lampshades

Pack lamps and lampshades individually in clean cartons with tissue filling. Bulbs and harps should be wrapped with packing paper and taped within the inside corners of the carton. Shades can be wrapped in tissue paper, avoid using newspapers, and put them in large cartons with tissue filling.

Silverware

Any silverware item should be wrapped in a cloth or a low sulphur content paper to prevent it from getting tarnished. An old blanket can also be used for preventing the silverware chest from any scratches.

Tools

Any power tools should be transported only after draining the fuel from them and should be packed in small but strong cartons. Valuable tools should be packed in separate cartons.

Waterbed

Mattresses

All waterbed mattresses should be drained off from water and folded by 20 inches at a [time](#), ensuring no creases are made across each fold. Avoid placing them in sharp objects.

Boxes/Cartons: Make sure you have enough boxes to pack your belongings. Make sure that the boxes are in good condition. Start collecting cartons from your local stores. Liquor stores have boxes with dividers that are perfect for cups/glasses. Save boxes from materials you have purchased. Also, it is an excellent idea to begin collecting boxes as soon as you are sure



you want to move.

Wrapping Paper: Things like newspaper, bubble wrap, and etc are important to keep your items protected. Use the cheapest available type of wrapping paper that you can to keep things protected. Some objects should be packed with



bubble wrap while newspaper is enough for other objects.

Plastic

Tape: Make sure you have thick plastic tape to seal your boxes. The tape should be approximately 2 inches wide in order to make sure the boxes are closed properly.



Permanent Marker: Permanent markers are necessary to mark your boxes. Write things like “Fragile” Or “Kitchen Supplies” to make sure you can distinguish your boxes. It may also be a good idea to write this in many places on the box. Finally, you should also make an arrow to make sure you know what direction you should open the box from. **Optional Supplies:** **Space Bags:** You can store clothing, blankets, and comforters in these bags. They condense your materials so they take less space and also help protect them. **Garment Boxes (Wardrobe Cartons):** You can buy these online or from your mover. They allow you to move your closet with the hangers still attached. **Specialized Boxes:** You can also purchase these from your mover. Unfortunately, you will probably need these



because things like mattress cartons are hard to find anywhere else.

Strapping: Some of your materials may need to be strapped down so strapping supplies are also a good thing to have. for more information
