
About the Book

- 4. There is tension between Henri's mother and grandmother. What is the reason for their disagreement? What do you do when family members argue?
- 5. Henri and her best friend Taffeta are very different from one another and yet they have a lot in common. What do you think makes their friendship work?
- 6. Taffeta and Henri's cousin P.J. can't agree on anything. Why do you think they argue so much?
- 7. When Henri learns that she is a Traveler it's kind of cool and completely unnerving. Have you ever experienced something that changed the way you think about yourself?
- 8. If you could choose a super ability, like being a Traveler, what would you choose? Why?
- 9. Henri, P.J., and Taffy all come from single parent families. Do you think this is a problem for them?
- 10. Henri is really smart, funny, and just a little bit chubby. Why do you think the mean girl only see the chubby part of her?
