Smiles Change Lives (SCL) is a national nonprofit organization that provides access to orthodontic treatment for children whose families cannot afford the full cost of braces, an average of \$5,000.

How does SCL work?

- 1. Families who can't afford the full cost of braces for their kids apply to SCL.
- 2. Caring and talented orthodontists donate their time and expertise to treat approved SCL participants.
- 3. SCL matches qualified, approved children with an SCL provider in their area and provides case management.

Program Guidelines:

- Applicants must be between the ages of 11-18, with moderate to severe malocclusions (crooked teeth and jaws).
- Applicants must have documented good oral hygiene as indicated in their application.
- Applicant families must prove financial need. Income guidelines are at www.smileschangelives.org/qualify.

 Applicants must complete all materials, pay a \$25 application fee and agree to comply with all program guidelines.
