From Earth Day to the first day of summer Chipper will visit community parks, state, and national parks, and outdoor retail locations like REI to excite and prepare children for adventures in the great outdoors.

We're looking for 50 Chipper Ambassadors to help lead activities and share stories–creating a virtual path to the great outdoors. Teachers, naturalists, parents and caregivers, and community leaders are invited to help share tips and ideas. Events will take place around the nation as well as other countries.

What is Chipper's Goal? To excite and ready children and families for camping, hiking, and outdoor fun! Early connections in nature help the physical and emotional well being of children and Chipper playfully teaches good character and a love for the environment–helping grow little ambassadors of nature into future stewards of the environment.
