Size Requirements

The minimum width of the CyberMaryland logo is 3"-



Use the stacked version when the width of the logo must be less than 2.5". Optimal width is 1.75".

Clear Area

Always maintain clear space around the logo, which includes the distance from the logo to the edge of a printed piece.

The clear area is defined by the height of the capitalized letters in CYBERMARYLAND. Three times the clear area should be maintained around the left and right of the logo, with the clear area itself maintained around the top and base to guarantee recognition.





Additional Guidelines

Do not use the logo at less than minimum size.

Do not outline the logo.

Do not add new elements—words or graphics—to the logo

Do not distort or manipulate the logo.

Do not use the logo as a pattern.

The preferred background for the logo is white.
